THE MOST IMPORTANT WEEK 1 FRONT PAGE IN YEARS

Any of you who are avid readers of the newsletter probably read the banquet issue from this past spring. In that issue, I outlined twelve rule and bylaw areas that I and/or other league members had identified over the past while as needing updating/changing. I sent those twelve items in an 8-page (yes, 8 pages... I'm sure the Board loves me right now) document that pointed out what the issues were, how they had affected things, and (in some cases) requested changes. Well, they took those items, and they tabled some that would take more thought and planning, they likely just dumped a couple, and the others... well, the others have already become immediate changes to the RDL and its week-to-week operations. Sooo...below is a list of rule change items that are effectively IMMEDIATELY. Please make mental note of all of these, save this page, write yourself notes, record the things we say at the preseason captains' meeting on your phone... just whatever... it is just critical that you take this into your RDL existence as truth at this very moment. (And to this end, every team has been given a copy of the rules at the captains' meeting (as they often are), but this time the copies are in full page printings, rather than 2 pages per side of the sheet - no getting any of these new things confused this time around. I recommend you carry your rules with you on dart nights...)

SCORESHEET RETURN DEADLINE

The weekly deadline for submission of your scoresheets is no longer the end of Saturday. The new deadline is 11:59 p.m. Friday (unless you had a rescheduled match - then it's within two days of whatever day you played). This rule change will affect very few of you, as most of you are Thursday/Friday scanners/faxers/emailers already. But for the two or three of you that for some reason have always felt the need to wait until Saturday evening to get out your phone, take a picture, and then send it to me (which you could have done days earlier), that Saturday time no longer works for you (unless you really really like mail penalties - if you do, then that time will be just perfect for you).

NO MORE VOICEMAIL CALL-INS

To go along with our new earlier scoresheet deadline, there will no longer be any match result call-in requirement of any kind. The reality is that most of you already took advantage of the rule that allowed early scoresheet submission to eliminate your weekly call requirement, so the VoiceMail system is... getting a little antiquated. We're going to keep the number around for a little while yet, so you can still leave me messages there... just please note that I will now be just sort of 'checking this whenever' instead of weekly. Thus, I might not notice your VoiceMail message right away. Probably easier to just shoot me an email...

EARBUD/HEADPHONE USAGE AT MATCHES

This one is creating a bit of discussion... For now, the rule will be this: players can wear earbuds/headphones during a match, while scorekeepers can not. Hilarious that the second part of that sentence even needs typing. And a note here, this is one of the least "settled" issues so far, so if you have further input this season, the Board will probably appreciate hearing it.

THROWING AFTER BUSTING IS ILLEGAL PRACTICE

Continuing to throw darts after clearly busting your turn is now officially against RDL rules. Obviously, if you hit a wire and didn't realize a dart was in, etc., changes the situation. But continuing to chuck away will be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct and is subject to the ladder of warnings/penalties that can come with those issues.

Sorry to the person who wanted to know what happens when the chalker's answer is "I don't know". That matched the Board's answer when they were asked what to do in that instance. :o)

HARD COPY TONS SLOWLY GOING AWAY?

It's 2017, literally half of the league members receive the Tons via email, and Phil Robertson has been posting the Tons to the website pretty quickly every week. And last season was the first in the league's history with fewer than half the teams still accepting a hard copy of the newsletter in the mail. Oh, yeah, and the postal service has extended its delivery times to such an extent that some areas don't always get the newsletter before the match. Thus, the new default will be no hard copy Tons for any team unless they specifically request to be added back to the snail mail list. For now, we are still mailing them to each of our host establishments, but it's only a matter of time until I convince the Board that the bars don't want any more paper in the mail than you guys do (he says, with his fingers crossed).

NO MORE 2ND PLACE TEAM PLAQUES

I'm not going to sugar coat it... 2nd place team plaques suck. Unless it's your very first dart award ever, who the hell wants a plaque that basically says "we finished behind 14% or 17% of our opposition" (depending on division size)? So, as of right now, **the second place team plaques have been discontinued**. If enough people voice opposition to this change, the Board is open to reinstating them, but for now, the parade of grudging walks to the podium to pick up the stack of expensive hardware that none of you want, is over.

WHAT SCOREKEEPERS CAN SAY DURING CRICKET

It is now official RDL policy that during cricket, the scorekeeper may only tell the thrower how many of each number has been hit during this turn, and may not report any more of the situation (whether a number is now closed, new point total, points still needed, etc.).

PLAYING THE WRONG OPPONENT

I was going to paraphrase what happens when people don't pay attention and go to the line and play the wrong person, but I think this one is just easier if I copy the rule here: "f) If a player plays a game on the wrong board (resulting in playing the incorrect opponent) regardless of when the error is discovered, if the entire match is not complete and the scoresheet signed, the game must be replayed. No statistics from the incorrectly played game are valid. If both players play on the "wrong" board but are playing the correct opponent, no action will be taken."

So that's it... for now. Go make sure you remember all of these changes - you're now responsible for playing by these new rules!

"HOT DARTS" LISTING GUIDELINES

Here are the guidelines that will be used for the minimum number of all-star points each week for the "hot darts" page.

"A" Div. = 4.5 or more ASPs; "B" Div. = 4.0 or more ASPs

"C, D" Divisions = 3.5 or more ASPs

"E, F, G" Divs. = 3.0 or more ASPs; "H" = 2.5 or more ASPs Also, we will list any fast games, high ins, high outs, or other amazing feats that you think warrant a little recognition (e.g., Ins & Outs higher than a Ton, 24-dart cricket games, 15-dart 301s, 24-dart 501s, Ton-70s and up, 5-Bulls+, etc.).

Extra note: it's also ok to call in "fast games" in each set, even if they don't necessarily meet the maximum dart counts above.

SEASON-LONG TROPHY DART MINIMUM GAMES PLAYED REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for all-star point ave. & singles win %-age awards, you must play at least 66% of this season's projected games: for Divisions "B", "C", "F" & "H" (8 teams / division):

min. of 19 Singles Games Played Singles win %-age: All-star pt. Average: min. of 37 Total Games Played for Divisions "A", "D", "E" & "G" (7 teams / division): Singles win %-age: min. of 16 Singles Games Played All-star pt. Average: min. of 32 Total Games Played

SEASON-LONG PREDICTIONS

JK's Standard Disclaimer: Rosters will change multiple times after I've written this, but that's out of my control. So, I go forward with some guesses every season. I could say nothing and let you wonder how ridiculously little I know about our talent levels, or I could do this, and remove all doubt. Wouldn't want to leave you wondering, right? (And yes, I get the schedules from Membership Director Heather Bohanan early enough to do separate week 1 picks nowadays, but you can probably glean most of those from this column...) "A" Division: Ok, not a whole lot of changing going on in most of A. One leader has to withstand a bit of a health issue for a while, another has streamlined its roster a bit, and a few others have made a pickup or two, but in the end, I think this division might come out quite a bit like the starting order of the season. Element will float along until Tom Brown returns, then I think it's game on time once again. The sleeker Appetite is clearly the top opposition, as their roster is pretty much as clean and balanced as a roster gets, ever. Dead Beats added a solid Persson, but they were solid already, and they'll outrun Fringe. And here's where the one big question lies... is Wilcenski's return to the Alliance roster "real"? If so, they go from a decent 5th to a factor in every match of their season. I think the Monkeys stay ahead of Alcohol Related, who returns to A with shiny new Carroll and Krasnow in tow. A is deep... "B" Division: How many times have the Fuquay guys with Holland/Rodgers/Murdaugh/etc. bounced back up to A? Well, whatever that somewhat impressive number is, add another one to it - they'll be right back in the top fight in the spring. Right behind them will be the steadily climbing Dartistic, especially if Simon Healy's resounding resurgence from last season continues. The enigmatic Niners are probably in line for third, with Rif Raf rounding out the top half (that Zawrotniak loss is big for them, but is this really Cusman's home? That would be a huge coup if he isn't really on that C team's roster). Kiss My, Menace, and The Bunkers will stay ahead of Methodical, I think, if for no reason beyond the John Wilson loss. "C" Division: Ok, now, is this division really Ryan Cusman's new home instead? Because if McGavin gets back Scott Sautter and adds Cusman, they can punch their tickets back to B right now. The nearly-never-changing Cheapies are probably about to hop a division too, as they'll inch past Long Shafts (formerly Mike's Garage), and Flightmare (who I would have picked much higher, but that Tufillaro defection is a big one). Next I'll go with Fire For Effect, but it feels weird to have neither Deb nor Kris here... good pickups in their places, but this is just an odd one to me. I'm guessing McDart Face will stay ahead of Cork, although I have to be honest that this a whole new Cork look... no Knight, no Schmaus, no Cotton... the rest of the core is here, but again, odd to me. And that leaves the G.O.O.F.S. - not sure what to make of them yet, although I will once again say that Randy Wilcox could own this non-A/B division yet again... not sure he is enough to push the team up the ladder though. "D" Division: Alright, I think D might be the most "static" of our sets of teams. Really only one major loss or addition to a roster, and if I know those guys, that loss will be talked back into playing any day now. That said, I think Dysfunctional gets the functionality back and bounces back up to C. They'll have to stay ahead of a Bandits squad that continues to get a little slimmer, a little sleeker, and ever more dangerous if they can avoid shorthanded nights. Pat's Blue has returned to their old name and will snag third, right ahead of Armed and Hammered (although John Jenkins could reappear on their roster by the time I'm finished typing this sentence). The Machine will then keep the two teams up from E from making too big of a dent in their new division's standings/circumstances.

"E" Division: And it's right here where we reach the point where zero teams have moved down into this division (just due to teams taking time off). So, no higher talent dropping down to deal with in this fight. Despite losing Kevin Scott, I think Coaching could pull out a win in what might be the most even race top-to-bottom in any division. Inglourious (previously All Flights Matter) made two big swaps, but look to be in line for a top-two spot, followed by a very dangerous WINNAU and the six-man Sofa Kings. Game of Throws, Death Throws and the Sharks round out the list, but every team here will win at least a few. "F" Division: After their week 3 additions last season, the Bull Hunters took off. I think they'll continue that here, despite the fact that the team has actually sort of split into two squads (the Cannizzaro absence is quite a big one). Scorekeeper picked up Chris Robertson and looks like a #2 squad in this fight, followed by Something Inappropriate (who didn't just develop a recent taste for winning, but also snagged Darren Schmaus). The Reefers will stay just ahead of Gretzky and the Cantwell-less Show Me. And after that are two huge question marks: are the Converses really gone from the Ducks? And who actually plays for the Elite? "G" Division: Bigtime turnover for Walking That Wire, but I think it will add up to a division title for them, although the only-two-Butterworth version of Bulls Up! will make it tough. Is It In? will likely pull down third, just ahead of the newly formed Cold Blooded and Thin Skinned (and likely division hammer Sebastian Dehnel). The Buddies lost a couple pieces, but brought in a far inferior second Gower to help cover (yep, Jeremy, we all love Devin, deal with it). Irish Ton and Chalker's Nightmare finish up the group, but this race could be messy. "H" Division: Several missing important team members around here, and a team of people I've never ever met before... perfect... this has prediction success written all over it. I'll go with Cupcake's Ballistic bunch, followed by maybe Chalk It Up? Maybe the Bombers next, and then Tips & Shafts (oh, holy cow, that Jon Lisk absence is a crusher). Then possibly All About, Why So Serious?, Just A Bit Outside, and then Dart Squad (the people I've never met in any capacity)? Can you guys feel my overwhelming sense of confidence in this pick set?

THE PAGE OF INFORMATION THAT I RUN EVERY SEASON...

This is the place where I remind all of you of several things so that you can't say "I didn't know that" later on when you screw up. Sort of takes the blame off me if any of these bad things happen... which I sort of consider to be a good thing...

Some of these things change over the years, some don't... but please read them again. This stuff is really important for the smooth flow of our nights out with our hobby.

COPIES OF COMPLETED SCORESHEETS

Keep a copy - it's as simple as that. I could give you all the reasons why, but I've done that a hundred times. Just **keep a copy of your sheet**, even if you lose, because you just never know when one of them will be lost by the postal service or your opponents. Hey, it has happened in <u>twenty-three of the last twenty-eight seasons</u>...

EMAILED TONS OF NEWSLETTER

Of course, we email the Tons of Newsletter. In fact, if I get my way, that might be soon the only way we distribute the newsletter (aside from posting it on the league website - another convenient and cost-effective electronic avenue). And if you were already on last season's list of Tons receivers, then you are still on the list. If you would like to be removed from the list, simply email me back and let me know. If you weren't on the list and you would like to receive it, just email my address listed on page 4 and I'll add you to the list. All you need is a relatively recent version of Microsoft Excel (or Acrobat Reader) to view it (and to not be a whiner, or an ass, or just difficult to like). I generally send the Tons out by Monday or Tuesday; however, if I forget then I apologize, but for now we don't guarantee delivery by any means other than the normal hard copy mail.

HOST ESTABLISHMENT EDITIONS OF TONS OF NEWS

For now at least, we still send hard copies of the Tons to each of our host establishments. And the edition for each of those host establishments is selected edition-wise based on which division holds the most of that bar's teams. If there is more than one division with the same number of teams in a given bar, then the highest division is the edition for that establishment.

SIMPLE TRUTHS THAT YOU SHOULD NEVER FORGET

- 1. Any player who plays in a match without properly registering and paying dues (with/to the League Membership Director, as she is also temporarily accepting seasonal dues payments) prior to throwing is an ineligible player. Playing an ineligible player will cost your team its win (if you did indeed win), all game points from that match, and all statistics from that match, regardless of how well or poorly that ineligible player did.
- 2. Any player who doesn't play in any of the four primary sets of the match, but plays in the 1001 tiebreaker is an ineligible player see number 1 (above) for the horror of this mistake.
- 3. Indicate which players of <u>both</u> teams took part in 1001 games on the front of the scoresheet. This is now <u>MANDATORY</u>, and allows us to check for ineligible players, record statistics, etc.
- 4. If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us a favor and call the opposing captain AND the VoiceMail... AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.
- 5. Wednesday player additions are not allowed. It turns out that Board members have dart matches too, so all roster additions are required to be completed no later than Tuesday for any player to play in that week's match.

MANY SCORESHEET RETURN PATHS AVAILABLE

Still an old school U.S. Postal Service fan? That's fine, as we still accept scoresheets via that method (and my address is actually on the back of the scoresheet so you can't lose it).

Or maybe you actually own a piece of technology, be it new or even not all that new... we likely have you covered too. We accept scoresheets through several additional "modern" methods:

- -- You can fax it to me (the fax number is in the newsletter every week, and is also on the back of the scoresheet).
- -- Or you can use your scanner and email me an image of the sheet (my email addresses are in the Tons every week and also on the back of the scoresheet).
- -- You can even shoot me photos of your scoresheet if you want to take care of returning it immediately! Just make sure you have good lighting, you're close enough to the sheet, and it's <u>IN FOCUS</u>. (note: out-of-focus or overly dark photos will not be acceptable... duh).

If you use any of these last three modern electronic methods, I'll even email you a quick confirmation of receipt if I have your email address (thus eliminating any worry on your end :0).

[Quick note if you do actually decide to send me a hard copy via the snail mail side of things. Buying a \$1.35 certificate of mailing could prove to be a nice piece of evidence if your scoresheet ever gets lost in the mail. Do NOT send your scoresheet by certified mail - I do NOT want to have to go to the post office repeatedly to sign for your scoresheets.]

NO CALL-IN REQUIREMENT FOR MATCH RESULTS

As of the Fall 2017 season, winning teams are no longer required to call in match results each week. The league will still have the Voice-Mail number for now (meaning that you can still call in tournament match results if you want), but no regular season weekly calls are needed. In fact, it's probably likely that that VoiceMail will not be checked with anywhere near the regularity that it once had.

TEAM NAMES ON YOUR SCORESHEETS

Every season there are several instances of teams listing the team names on opposite sides of the scoresheets (meaning that one team's name is written above the other team's players). Obviously, I will eventually figure these out when the names under a team name aren't on the roster, but it would be cool if you simply indicate the error in some way (or simply flip the names - I would rather an away team be on the home side and vice versa than have the wrong people AND THUS BACKWARDS FINAL SCORE under each side). Thanks.

CHECK BOTH SCORESHEETS

We run an item like this every season, and sometimes more than once. And here it is again because we always happens repeatedly. When you are signing scoresheets at the end of the night, it is up to you to make sure that they match. If the other team turns in a sheet without your ASP or fast game or something, it really sort of doesn't exist... In RDL, not on the sheet = didn't happen.
