

## ***ONE OF THOSE SEASONS WHERE WE ADD A DIVISION...***

Alright, in what is hopefully just the "next step" in a long series of them in the right direction, we have re-expanded our team list back up to 49 this season (after having 45 last season and 56 in our last pre-pandemic season). So the league shrank 11 teams last season due to Covid, and now we've regained 36% of that team loss. Nice. But what that also means is that we've re-expanded from the 6 divisions we had in the Fall season to the 7 we have now. Which means that teams could not just simply "move top two up and drop bottom two down" and have it make any sense (since there is now an entire extra division at the bottom end of the list). This means that what had to be done was to basically take last season's finishing positions in one long ordered list, then move teams up or down in the sequence if they had finished top-two or bottom-two, and then re-cut the division lines from the entire team order instead of just "up to D from E" or something like that. Thus, if you won a division and are in the same division as last season, that might well equate to actually moving up since the entire league was re-stretched out into seven divisions again. Just important to realize before anybody gives voice to any sort of "unwarranted" complaints about seeding.

### **A LIST OF RECENT IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

#### **FAILURE TO INCLUDE "BLOCKER" NAMES**

In games with a shorthanded team (and thus, one or more "blockers"), failure to list the names of all competitors in those games will bear a consequence for BOTH teams. If the submitted scoresheet is missing names, BOTH teams will receive a 5-point penalty.

#### **RESCHEDULING? MAKE SURE I KNOW ABOUT IT**

Failure to notify the statistician of a rescheduled match in the proper timeframe is now a 16-point penalty for each team.

#### **FORFEIT ETIQUETTE**

If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us all an easy favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.

#### **NO MORE 2ND PLACE TEAM PLAQUES**

Roughly one team in the league has voiced any opposition to this change, and that was a drunken rant a few years ago now. The reality is that the 2nd place team plaques had little meaning, and almost nobody still wants to take one home. Thus, the second place team plaques were discontinued a few years ago.

#### **THROWING AFTER BUSTING IS ILLEGAL PRACTICE**

Continuing to throw darts after clearly busting your turn is now officially against RDL rules. Obviously, if you hit a wire and didn't realize a dart was in, etc., changes the situation. But continuing to chuck away will be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct and is subject to the ladder of warnings/penalties that can come with those issues.

#### **WHAT SCOREKEEPERS CAN SAY DURING CRICKET**

It is now official RDL policy that during cricket, the scorekeeper may only tell the thrower how many of each number has been hit during this turn, and may not report any more of the situation (whether a number is now closed, new point total, points still needed, etc.).

#### **PLAYING THE WRONG OPPONENT**

I was going to paraphrase what happens when people don't pay attention and go to the line and play the wrong person, but I think this one is just easier if I copy the rule here: "f) If a player plays a game on the wrong board (resulting in playing the incorrect opponent) regardless of when the error is discovered, if the entire match is not complete and the scoresheet signed, the game must be replayed. No statistics from the incorrectly played game are valid. If both players play on the "wrong" board but are playing the correct opponent, no action will be taken."

#### **EARBUD/HEADPHONE USAGE AT MATCHES**

This one still pops up now and then, but the ruling was made seasons ago... As of Fall 2017: players can wear earbuds/headphones during a match, while scorekeepers can not. Hilarious that the second part of that sentence even needs typing.

### **HANDLE BUSINESS BEFORE WEDNESDAYS...**

If you want to add a player(s) to your roster, they cannot play until they are approved and their dues are paid. And those additions and/or changes cannot be done on Wednesdays (even during the day on Wed.), as the Membership Director & Treasurer (yes, both are currently the same person) have their matches that day as well.

### **SCORESHEETS**

You have 3 copies in your team packet. Clearly, you'll need to make some copies for the remainder of the season. Don't forget.

### **SCORESHEET RETURN DEADLINE**

The weekly deadline for submission of your scoresheets is no longer the end of Saturday. **The new deadline as of the Fall 2017 season is 11:59 p.m. Friday** (unless you had a rescheduled match - then it's within two days of whatever day you played).

### **1001 PARTICIPANT LISTING IS MANDATORY**

Inclusion of the player names for all 1001 participants for BOTH teams on the scoresheet is mandatory! Failure to include those names will incur a penalty equal to a late scoresheet mailing penalty. There is even a box on the front of the scoresheet for names!

### **ROSTER UPDATES AND SPELLING**

Please note: rosters provided in this preseason packet include only players added prior to Jan. 18th. Later additions will appear on the team statistics pages beginning in week 2. Also, please check the spellings and phone numbers from your roster listing - note any changes on your scoresheet or send me an email.

### **HOSTING TOURNAMENT MATCHES**

It is the responsibility of the CAPTAINS (not the RDL board) to ensure their host bars are informed of the tournament schedule when it is released around weeks 12/13. A new rule provision allows host bars to opt out of the tournament rotation, if they want to be done with darts after the regular season. However, they must notify the membership director by week 5, if that is the case.

Here are the guidelines that will be used for the minimum number of all-star points each week for the "hot darts" page.

"A" Div. = 4.5 or more ASPs; "B" Div. = 4.0 or more ASPs

"C, D" Divisions = 3.5 or more ASPs

"E, F" Divs. = 3.0 or more ASPs; "G" = 2.5 or more ASPs

Also, we will list any fast games, high ins, high outs, or other amazing feats that you think warrant a little recognition (e.g., Ins & Outs higher than a Ton, 24-dart cricket games, 15-dart 301s, 24-dart 501s, Ton-70s and up, 5-Bulls+, etc.).

*Extra note: it's also ok to call in "fast games" in each set, even if they don't necessarily meet the maximum dart counts above.*

To be eligible for all-star point ave. & singles win %-age awards, you must play at least 66% of this season's projected games:

**SEASON-LONG PREDICTIONS**

*JK's Standard Disclaimer* : Rosters will change multiple times after I've written this, but that's out of my control. So, I go forward with some guesses every season. I could say nothing and let you wonder how ridiculously little I know about our talent levels, or I could do this, and remove all doubt. Wouldn't want to leave you wondering, right? (And yes, I get the schedules from Membership Director Heather Bohanan early enough to do separate week 1 picks nowadays, but you can probably glean most of those from this column...)

**"A" Division:** Well, this is probably the easiest pick on the page. The Bullies are quite possibly the single most stacked team in RDL history, with national and state champions up and down the roster, with near-champs filling the backup spots. It's probably fair to say that anything short of an undefeated season will be a letdown, and their goals should likely be more like all-time win percentage, all-star point, and fast game records. But beyond the obvious, both Alliance and Element will still be dangerous second fiddles, followed by Liver Die and a very-new-look Fringe. The teams up from B are both pretty talented as well, and either has a real shot at becoming longtime residents in the top division landscape.

**"B" Division:** This one is pretty interesting, as what would generally be considered the top 3-5 teams returning to this section of teams all experienced one or more significant losses. Just Happened is down Klann, Gibbs and Akos. The Hurlers lost Tom Winters (but made a nice Shengulette replacement acquisition). And Boom is now without key part-timer Joey G. And beyond that, Armed lost Patrick Howsare. And the Nonessentials basically lost half their team (but do not sleep on that quiet Jimmy Davis addition). And none of those stories even note that Sid Mitchell and Tex Mozzetti are now leading up a wild mixed squad in B land!! This race could be crazy. Seriously, this a wild gunslinger mess. In the end, I guess I'll take Armed, just ahead of the Hurlers, Boom, and Nonessentials. But make no mistake, I'm unabashedly rooting for The Replacements and all that underlies the team's existence - I think there's a chance that every single one of their matches will end in the range of 14-10 to 10-14, regardless of level of opponent - they're going to need antacids.

**"C" Division:** More reforming of pre-Covid power alliances going on here... The Darty Minds have gone back to their Reitano/Maccini roots, the Garage has realigned itself, and Dr.unk is back in its prior-ish form. In addition, we now have Simon Healy and Bob Lane sightings! Exciting stuff here in C, as this lineup makes things feel more "normal" than a lot of things have felt for two years now. If Sal and Billy are really back and playing, I have to take Darty Minds, as that team has near-A talent throughout. The John Suan addition and the Healy/Lane adds will bring in Dr.unk and Frankie next, followed closely by the Outlaws (who might well go 1-1 against every team). The Garage, Niners and Antique-less DD round things out.

**"D" Division:** Wow, Rif Raf certainly went out and found themselves some nice ways to avoid playing shorthanded, adding both Winters and Howsare. Not to be outdone, Big Bulls made a huge addition in Patrick Akos. But not to be outdone by an even larger margin, Hump Day picked up RDL legend (and I say that with zero worry of inaccuracy) Bob Terry. Holy cow, all the way around. I think I will go with the Big Bulls despite the higher recent pedigrees of a few teams here, followed by Rif Raf, Off Constantly, Hump Day and the Sharks. Which somehow leaves Methodical and Cheapies in the bottom? Oh, yikes, that doesn't feel likely either..

**"E" Division:** While a lot of divisions and teams are defined by who is new to a roster, for me E division is marked by what isn't here... how the heck is Dave Johnson not the captain of Menace?? This just feels... wrong. I'm completely thrown off by that absence, and I have zero confidence in my picks here now. Nice to see Sippin' & Trippin' (formerly Treble Yell) return, so that's very cool at least. Somehow, I think I'm picking the Bandits for about the 7,826th time (I've been right maybe twice), just ahead of Sanchez, the Machine, and Sippin' & Trippin'. The Rangers and She Said get the next spots, because I'm putting Dave-less Menace last as my own protest.

**"F" Division:** Alright, getting into a pretty interesting mix of finishes in the fè season's standings, making for a pretty cool mix here in F. I think I kind of have to go with No Consensus, as they felt like they were really on the edge of moving up from this level all of last season. Behind them, I'm going with the pretty new look of Twisted Fork, and then we'll find out how Death Throw will fare with more than 6 on the roster. The Dart Knights are deep and slide in next, just ahead of teams that feature two of the division's top guns, Som Samaluk (Ducks) and Dave Finney (Backpfeif - because that's what we are going to shorten that to a lot this season).

**"G" Division:** Ummm... where are Becky and Hugh? Welp, in their absence, I'm taking Coach to take G. Banging and Shoot To Thrill will squeeze in ahead of Ones and Sofa, I think, and then we're going to go with the newcomer Rippin Darts. It's always super hard to slot a team of full newcomers, but I always like to put them up at least a slot or two in case it's a bunch of guns-to-be that I've just never met.

# THE PAGE OF INFORMATION THAT I RUN EVERY SEASON...

This is the place where I remind all of you of several things so that you can't say "I didn't know that" later on when you screw up. Sort of takes the blame off me if any of these bad things happen... which I sort of consider to be a good thing...

Some of these things change over the years, some don't... but please read them again.

This stuff is really important for the smooth flow of our nights out with our hobby.

## COPIES OF COMPLETED SCORESHEETS

Keep a copy - it's as simple as that. I could give you all the reasons why, but I've done that a hundred times. Just **keep a copy of your sheet**, even if you lose, because you just never know when one of them will be lost by the postal service or your opponents. Hey, it has happened in twenty-four of the last thirty-four season...

## EMAILED TONS OF NEWSLETTER

Of course, we email the Tons of Newsletter. In fact, that's the only way we distribute the newsletter in today's modern age (aside from posting it on the league website - another convenient and cost-effective electronic avenue). And if you were already on last season's list of Tons receivers, then you are still on the list. If you would like to be removed from the list, simply email me back and let me know. If you weren't on the list and you would like to receive it, just email my address listed on page 4 and I'll add you to the list. All you need is a relatively recent version of Microsoft Excel (or Acrobat Reader) to view it (and to not be a whiner, or an ass, or just difficult to like). I generally send the Tons out in the range of Sunday to Tuesday; however, if I get delayed a bit in some week, then I apologize, but it will be coming soon.

## NO MORE HARD COPY TONS

For decades, the RDL mailed hard copies of the Tons to each team each week. Then we eventually cut that back to mailing them to just the host establishments each week. And now it's finally time that we complete the transition to the modern electronic age, and drop the hard copies altogether (except preseason and banquet issues). If anybody still needs a hard copy, let me know and we'll handle it.

## SIMPLE TRUTHS THAT YOU SHOULD NEVER FORGET

1. Any player who plays in a match without properly registering and paying dues (with/to the League Membership Director, as she is also temporarily accepting seasonal dues payments) prior to throwing is an ineligible player. Playing an ineligible player will cost your team its win (if you did indeed win), all game points from that match, and all statistics from that match, regardless of how well or poorly that ineligible player did.
2. Any player who doesn't play in any of the four primary sets of the match, but plays in the 1001 tiebreaker is an ineligible player - see number 1 (above) for the horror of this mistake.
3. Indicate which players of both teams took part in 1001 games on the front of the scoresheet. This is now MANDATORY, and allows us to check for ineligible players, record statistics, etc.
4. If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us a favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.
5. Wednesday player additions are not allowed. It turns out that Board members have dart matches too, so all roster additions are required to be completed no later than Tuesday for any player to play in that week's match.

## MANY SCORESHEET RETURN PATHS AVAILABLE - BUT NOT ENTIRELY THE SAME AS IN RECENT YEARS!

We have three routes remaining for turning in your scoresheets..

First, you can use your scanner (or your phone in some cases and email me an image of the sheet (my email addresses are in the Tons every week and also on the back of the scoresheet)

Second, you can shoot me photos of your scoresheet if you want to take care of returning it immediately! Just make sure you have good lighting, you're close enough to the sheet, and it's IN FOCUS. (note: out-of-focus or overly dark photos will not be acceptable... duh). And you can send those photos by email or text (as with my email addresses, my phone number is on the scoresheet back).

Finally, you can still use the old school U.S. Postal Service. My address is also on the back of the scoresheet, but I caution you... I predict that this system will go away before too long (as I haven't received one via this route for a couple years now... plus the duration of a pandemic!).

[Quick note if you do actually decide to send me a hard copy via the snail mail side of things. Buying a (\$1.35-ish?) certificate of mailing could prove to be a nice piece of evidence if your scoresheet ever gets lost in the mail. Do NOT send your scoresheet by certified mail - I do NOT want to have to go to the post office repeatedly (or at all, to be honest) to sign for your scoresheets.]

*If you use any of the modern electronic methods, I'll even email or text you a quick confirmation of receipt (since I'll have your email address or phone number, of course) - thus eliminating any worry about whether the sheet got through to me :o).*

## NO CALL-IN REQUIREMENT FOR MATCH RESULTS

As of the Fall 2017 season, winning teams are no longer required to call in match results each week. And actually, the league is now at the point where we have discontinued the VoiceMail number. Not enough use of it to warrant the cost any longer.

## TEAM NAMES ON YOUR SCORESHEETS

Every season there are several instances of teams listing the team names on opposite sides of the scoresheets (meaning that one team's name is written above the other team's players). Obviously, I will eventually figure these out when the names under a team name aren't on the roster, but it would be cool if you simply indicate the error in some way (or simply flip the names - I would rather an away team be on the home side and vice versa than have the wrong people ANI THUS BACKWARDS FINAL SCORE under each side). Thanks

## CHECK BOTH SCORESHEETS

We run an item like this every season, and sometimes more than once. And here it is again because it's often needed repeatedly. When you are signing scoresheets at the end of the night, it is up to you to make sure that they match. If the other team turns in a sheet without your ASP or fast game or something, it really sort of doesn't exist... In RDL, not on the sheet = didn't happen.
