TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY

Unlike in many previous years, simply having your dues paid is no longer enough for a player to be eligible to play in the postseason tournaments. Now a player must also take part in 4 regular season matches. Please note the far right column on page 10 for your division to see who is/isn't eligible for play in your tournament matches (players with 4+ are eligible). There are 30 players that are tournament-ineligible: 5 in A division, 4 in B, 4 in C, 7 in D, 4 in E, 3 in F, and 3 in G.

FINAL DIVISIONAL STATISTICS

Final statistics are available for all 7 divisions in this issue of the Tons of Newsletter, as all scoresheets have been received already. Please check your entire team's statistics for accuracy. **If there are any discrepancies with any of your team's statistics, and you want a recheck of the records, I'll give everyone through this Sunday (May 8th) to let me know about them. Here are the guidelines that will be used for the minimum number of all-star points each week for the "hot darts" page.

"A" Div. = 4.5 or more ASPs; "B" Div. = 4.0 or more ASPs

"C, D" Divisions = 3.5 or more ASPs

"E, F" Divs. = 3.0 or more ASPs; "G" = 2.5 or more ASPs

Also, we will list any fast games, high ins, high outs, or other amazing feats that you think warrant a little recognition (e.g., Ins & Outs higher than a Ton, 24-dart cricket games, 15-dart 301s, 24-dart 501s, Ton-70s and up, 5-Bulls+, etc.).

Extra note: it's also ok to call in "fast games" in each set, even if they don't necessarily meet the maximum dart counts above.

WINNER

SOMETIMES THE BIG MATCH DELIVERS

We've had lots of "match of the year" candidates over the years, and a lot of them end up being sort of so-so. Well, not last week's!! TOURNAMENT PREDICTIONS

Solid 16-5 in the final week takes me to 220-74 for the season (which was one dang pick from surpassing 75% correct... bummer... week 13 cost me). Only one team (Dart Side of the Moon) ended with a record where I got more wrong than right, and that one was only 5-7. Decent.

"A" Division: Ok, the Alliance is really good, but after seeing Bullies and Element tangle twice, I absolutely have to go with that as the final here. Based on the story above, I have to go with The Bullies (but will be pulling for the opposite!). Obviously, Alliance will make the semis, and I think Fringe *finally* gets past Liver for the first time this season.

"B" Division: Even the 1-win team in B wins 42% of its games... and not one team in the division managed to win 56% of its games... this is probably the most wide-open division around. Nearly anything could happen. So let's guess!! I super want to take the Nonessentials, but their road is sooo hard. So in the end, I'll take Armed over Boom Baby in the final, with the Hurlers and Nonessentials also advancing once.

Tom Brown (of The Uncharted Element in A), Tim Lane (of Shark Shooters in D) and Allen Smith (of The Uncharted Element in A) were all on the A division all-star team; Randy Baldwin (of Hump Day! in D) and Mike Seward (of North Raleigh Alliance in A) were on the B team; Doug Jeffcoat (of Consistently Inconsistent in B) was on the D team; Mark Powell (of Red-eye Rangers in E) was on the E team (and is the only person in this answer still on basically the same team!); and Dawn Clement (of Backpfeifengesicht in F) and Barry Jackson (of Hump Day Hurlers in B) were on the G team.

WHO DIDN'T PLAY?! Another good season of stuff!!

Some seasons this is one of my favorite items - the one where I report which individual leaders sat out sets in the final week. Although we can never be certain of the reason that somebody sits out, I'm sure we all have our guesses, and knowing who to guess about is lots of fun.
