TWO IMPORTANT NOTES (STILL HERE) FOR SPRING 2023

The alignment of teams into divisions this season - this time only in the lower divisions

As is relatively common (especially when the team number is changing, such as during the progression back from a pandemic-fueled lull), teams form, teams return, etc. And if an expanded number of teams that form/return have clear lower-end or clear higher-end talent, that situation necessitates pushing the team stack up or down a bit more than might have been expected by some teams. Thus, you might be in a higher division this season than you expected - rest assured that this was not an error, but rather is a response to team formation dynamics.

New Rules that apply to the use of DartConnect

Each team (and all people on the RDL email list) received a new set of rules updated last season. Please do note the recent rule changes that pertain to using DartConnect devices to keep score. It is critical that everyone understand what is/isn't allowed, and what it takes to "agree" to use the device. Find them in these sections: MATCHES.F.1 [page 5 of 12 in the rules], and MATCHES.F.4.b.5 [page 6 of 12 in the rules]

A LIST OF RECENT IMPORTANT REMINDERS

FAILURE TO INCLUDE "BLOCKER" NAMES

In games with a shorthanded team (and thus, one or more "blockers"), failure to list the names of all competitors in those games will bear a consequence for BOTH teams. If the submitted scoresheet is missing names, BOTH teams will receive a 5-point penalty.

RESCHEDULING? MAKE SURE I KNOW ABOUT IT

Failure to notify the statistician of a rescheduled match in the proper timeframe is now a 16-point penalty for each team.

FORFEIT ETIQUETTE

If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us all an easy favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.

NO MORE 2ND PLACE TEAM PLAQUES

Roughly one team in the league has voiced any opposition to this change, and that was a drunken rant a few years ago now. The reality is that the 2nd place team plaques had little meaning, and almost nobody still wants to take one home. Thus, the second place team plaques were discontinued a few years ago.

THROWING AFTER BUSTING IS ILLEGAL PRACTICE

Continuing to throw darts after clearly busting your turn is now officially against RDL rules. Obviously, if you hit a wire and didn't realize a dart was in, etc., changes the situation. But continuing to chuck away will be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct and is subject to the ladder of warnings/penalties that can come with those issues.

WHAT SCOREKEEPERS CAN SAY DURING CRICKET

It is now official RDL policy that during cricket, the scorekeeper may only tell the thrower how many of each number has been hit during this turn, and may not report any more of the situation (whether a number is now closed, new point total, points still needed, etc.).

PLAYING THE WRONG OPPONENT

I was going to paraphrase what happens when people don't pay attention and go to the line and play the wrong person, but I think this one is just easier if I copy the rule here: "f) If a player plays a game on the wrong board (resulting in playing the incorrect opponent) regardless of when the error is discovered, if the entire match is not complete and the scoresheet signed, the game must be replayed. No statistics from the incorrectly played game are valid. If both players play on the "wrong" board but are playing the correct opponent, no action will be taken."

EARBUD/HEADPHONE USAGE AT MATCHES

This one still pops up now and then, but the ruling was made seasons ago... As of Fall 2017: players can wear earbuds/headphones during a match, while scorekeepers can not. Hilarious that the second part of that sentence even needs typing.

HANDLE BUSINESS BEFORE WEDNESDAYS...

If you want to add a player(s) to your roster, they cannot play until they are approved and their dues are paid. And those additions and/or changes cannot be done on Wednesdays (even during the day on Wed.), as the Membership Director and Treasurer both have their matches to play that day as well.

SCORESHEETS

You have 3 copies in your team packet. Clearly, you'll need to make some copies for the remainder of the season. Don't forget.

SCORESHEET RETURN DEADLINE

The weekly deadline for submission of your scoresheets is no longer the end of Saturday. **The new deadline as of the Fall 2017 season is 11:59 p.m. Friday** (unless you had a rescheduled match - then it's within two days of whatever day you played).

1001 PARTICIPANT LISTING IS MANDATORY

Inclusion of the player names for all 1001 participants for BOTH teams on the scoresheet is mandatory! Failure to include those names will incur a penalty equal to a late scoresheet mailing penalty. There is even a box on the front of the scoresheet for names!

ROSTER UPDATES AND SPELLING

Please note: rosters provided in this preseason packet include only players added prior to Jan. 16th. Later additions will appear on the team statistics pages beginning in week 2. Also, please check the spellings and phone numbers from your roster listing - note any changes on your scoresheet or send me an email.

HOSTING TOURNAMENT MATCHES

It is the responsibility of the CAPTAINS (not the RDL board) to ensure their host bars are informed of the tournament schedule when it is released around weeks 12/13. A recent rule provision allows host bars to opt out of the tournament rotation, if they want to be done with darts after the regular season. However, they must notify the membership director by week 5, if that is the case.

Anyway, the names are what they are, and at least if they stay the same, it's easy to know who you're facing on the schedule each week. Either way, let's check in on my personal favorites of the season, with a bit of an explanation as to why:

"HOT DARTS" LISTING GUIDELINES

Here are the guidelines that will be used for the minimum number of all-star points each week for the "hot darts" page.

"A" Div. = 4.5 or more ASPs; "B" Div. = 4.0 or more ASPs

"C, D" Divisions = 3.5 or more ASPs

"E, F" Divs. = 3.0 or more ASPs; "G" = 2.5 or more ASPs

Also, we will list any fast games, high ins, high outs, or other amazing feats that you think warrant a little recognition (e.g., Ins & Outs higher than a Ton, 24-dart cricket games, 15-dart 301s, 24-dart 501s, Ton-70s and up, 5-Bulls+, etc.).

Extra note: it's also ok to call in "fast games" in each set, even if they don't necessarily meet the maximum dart counts above.

SEASON-LONG TROPHY DART MINIMUM GAMES PLAYED REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for all-star point ave. & singles win %-age awards, you must play at least 66% of this season's projected games:

for Divisions "A", "C", "D", "E" and "G" (7 teams / division):

Singles win %-age: min. of 16 Singles Games Played

All-star pt. Average: min. of 32 Total Games Played

for Divisions "B" and "F" (8 teams / division):

Singles win %-age: min. of 19 Singles Games Played

All-star pt. Average: min. of 37 Total Games Played

SEASON-LONG PREDICTIONS

JK's Standard Disclaimer : Rosters will change multiple times after I've written this, but that's out of my control. So, I go forward with some guesses every season. I could say nothing and let you wonder how ridiculously little I know about our talent levels, or I could do this, and remove all doubt. Wouldn't want to leave you wondering, right? (And yes, I get the schedules from Membership Director Heather Bohanan early enough to do separate week 1 picks nowadays, but you can probably glean most of those from this column...)

"A" Division: This is about the most "static" I've seen A division in a very long time. Add one Gibbs, remove one Work, and the rest of the lineups are largely the same. So theoretically, I should do very well in these picks then, right? Well, if we expect what I type here to come to fruition, I'm completely taking my Element guys to take the top spot! Duh. In second will of course be The Bullies, who will play three matches against Element this season, and MAYBE one of them will inflate to a monster 14-10 whooping (along with two tiebreakers, because, of course). I'm guessing Liver's loss of Work will maybe let Fringe inch ahead of Liver for third, with Armed, then Inconsistent and Darty. If Gibbs catches a little old magic, adding him to the very-real-deal Jimmie Jones gives Inconsistent some high upset potential.

"B" Division: I'm going to go ahead and warn B division not to overlook the or new team in the league this season. Iceman's Ear Defenders are new to RDL, but they are WAY not new to darts. Some heavy duty shots in that lineup, and I think they will be a major player in this race. I'll take Why So Serious (as long as they don't stack multiple penalties this season) as the winner, but I'll take Iceman's next. They will be followed by Matt's Tab, Boom Baby (who might be a bit more popular this season?), and then Blindsided (who had a couple big changes, but I fear they will miss Gaglione/Sweeny). Outlaws and Dart Attack will sneak ahead of Uber Out, and it's right about here that I'm fairly certain that B is going to haunt me all season - I just put a very talented team last. Crap, I'm going to get a lot of picks wrong here.

"C" Division: Quite a bit of consistency here in C too. The only real big additic I see is Terry Blake joining Show Me Your Tips. There was a chance I was going to take Show Me anyway, but I'm definitely taking them now. Stumble Out did the only other bit of roster jumbling, but I think they are going to be about the same level and will haul in second. The ever-confusing Nine Lives is likely to post enough huge wins and stunning crumbings to end up third, followed by Rif Raf and then Trippin Bulls. I'm not sure how I possibly think McGavin is going from B to 6th in C, but here we are, so... And finally, I have Sanchez in last. All Sanchez has ever done is win. Could that possibly be hitting a speed bump here in C? Oy, I'm toast.

"D" Division: Oh boy, the hits just keep coming. After a couple divisions that seemed really tough to pick, this one feels high impossible. I'm fairly certain the winner will be no better than 8-4 (which means I have little chance to get this order right). I'm going to avoid picking the Bandits yet again, and I'll take Off Constantly (despite their loss of Lou Tuffillaro). BullsHit will nab a climb to C, followed by the Bandits, and then the Red-eye Rangers. I have Cheapies in fifth, but I'm really not sure how this team doesn't win more - I could conceivably see them fighting for the title. Anyway, DD-214 (without Hiker Jim) and Menace will round things out.

"E" Division: Every now and then, a division story is all about the movement of single player. And this is one of those times. The Ducks and Irish Ton would've both been contenders here in their previous forms, but with Dave Finney hopping over to the Ducks, I am sooooo taking the Ducks to take this race. They now have a few real guns, and a few-season-climb could be in the works. I'm thinking Hump Day will bounce right back up to D, and Death Throw will make a very nice showing after climbing up from F. Machine should be in the middle, just ahead of the very-new-look Irish Ton (kinda guessing when a team is this different), followed by She Said (who I'm thinking will feel the loss of Michael Tanella) and Y.N.T.A.

"F" Division: Aside from a team slimming down, and a team sort of half-forming out of a team from last season, the F rosters are pretty consistent. Which means... this one is going to go Ton 80 Proof's way. They will just escape Dart Side and Bangin in a recreation of the super close race those three waged in the middle of F just last season. We'll go with Dart Knights next, just in front of the G-winning Sofa Kings and their top rivals the Village Idiots. Then the Sharks will slide in ahead of Shoot-Da-Bull, who is actually a pretty interesting group that might surprise a bit.

"G" Division: Remember last season when Rippin Darts "almost" won everythin in G? Well, the two teams that were the thorns in their sides are both gone. So, as long as their current only-six-player roster doesn't get in the way, this race is Rippin's. The Punk in Drublic half of the old Thrill will snag second, followed by the reunified Ones are Closed, and then Nein Mark. I guess next will be the Corkers (who have a very different roster, sadly without the awesome Dana Bither), and then We Throw It will keep the Rock Bottoms from becoming the Rock Climbers just yet.

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THE PAGE OF INFORMATION THAT I RUN EVERY SEASON...

This is the place where I remind all of you of several things so that you can't say "I didn't know that" later on when you screw up. Sort of takes the blame off me if any of these bad things happen... which I sort of consider to be a good thing...

Some of these things change over the years, some don't... but please read them again.

This stuff is really important for the smooth flow of our nights out with our hobby.

COPIES OF COMPLETED SCORESHEETS

Keep a copy - it's as simple as that. I could give you all the reasons why, but I've done that a hundred times. Just **keep a copy of your sheet**, even if you lose, because you just never know when one of them will be lost by the postal service or your opponents. Hey, it has happened in twenty-five of the last thirty-six seasons...

EMAILED TONS OF NEWSLETTER

Of course, we email the Tons of Newsletter. In fact, that's the only way we distribute the newsletter in today's modern age (aside from posting it on the league website - another convenient and cost-effective electronic avenue). And if you were already on last season's list of Tons receivers, then you are still on the list. If you would like to be removed from the list, simply email me back and let me know. If you weren't on the list and you would like to receive it, just email my address listed on page 4 and I'll add you to the list. All you need is a relatively recent version of Microsoft Excel (or Acrobat Reader) to view it (and to not be a whiner, or an ass, or just difficult to like). I generally send the Tons out in the range of Sunday to Tuesday; however, if I get delayed a bit in some week, then I apologize, but it will be coming soon.

NO MORE HARD COPY TONS

For decades, the RDL mailed hard copies of the Tons to each team each week. Then we eventually cut that back to mailing them to just the host establishments each week. Now we've finally completed the transition to the modern electronic age, and dropped the hard copies altogether (except preseason and banquet issues). If anyone has issues with these versions, let me know and we'll figure it out.

SIMPLE TRUTHS THAT YOU SHOULD NEVER FORGET

1. Any player who plays in a match without properly registering and paying dues (register with the League Membership Director, pay the League Treasurer) prior to throwing is an ineligible player. Playing an ineligible player will cost your team its win (if you did indeed win), all game points from that match, and all statistics from that match, regardless of how well or poorly that ineligible player did.
2. Any player who doesn't play in any of the four primary sets of the match, but plays in the 1001 tiebreaker is an ineligible player - see number 1 (above) for the horror of this mistake.
3. Indicate which players of both teams took part in 1001 games on the front of the scoresheet. This is now MANDATORY, and allows us to check for ineligible players, record statistics, etc.
4. If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us a favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.
5. Wednesday player additions are not allowed. It turns out that Board members have dart matches too, so all roster additions are required to be completed no later than Tuesday for any player to play in that week's match.

MANY SCORESHEET RETURN PATHS AVAILABLE - BUT NOT ENTIRELY THE SAME AS IN RECENT YEARS

We have three routes remaining for turning in your scoresheets..

First, you can use your scanner (or your phone in some cases) and email me an image of the sheet (my email addresses are in the Tons every week and also on the back of the scoresheet)

Second, you can shoot me photos of your scoresheet if you want to take care of returning it immediately! Just make sure you have good lighting, you're close enough to the sheet, and it's IN FOCUS. (note: out-of-focus or overly dark photos will not be acceptable... duh). And you can send those photos by email or text (as with my email addresses, my phone number is on the scoresheet back).

Finally, you can still use the old school U.S. Postal Service. My address is also on the back of the scoresheet, but I caution you... I predict that this system will go away before too long (as I haven't received one via this route for a couple years now... plus the duration of a pandemic!).

[Quick note if you do actually decide to send me a hard copy via the snail mail side of things. Buying a (\$1.50-ish?) certificate of mailing could prove to be a nice piece of evidence if your scoresheet ever gets lost in the mail. Do NOT send your scoresheet by certified mail - I do NOT want to have to go to the post office repeatedly (or at all, to be honest) to sign for your scoresheets.]

If you use any of the modern electronic methods, I'll even email or text you a quick confirmation of receipt (since I'll have your email address or phone number, of course) - thus eliminating any worry about whether the sheet got through to me :o).

NO CALL-IN REQUIREMENT FOR MATCH RESULTS

As of the Fall 2017 season, winning teams are no longer required to call in match results each week. And actually, the league is now at the point where we have discontinued the VoiceMail number. Not enough use of it to warrant the cost any longer.

TEAM NAMES ON YOUR SCORESHEETS

Every season there are several instances of teams listing the team names on opposite sides of the scoresheets (meaning that one team's name is written above the other team's players). Obviously, I will eventually figure these out when the names under a team name aren't on the roster, but it would be cool if you simply indicate the error in some way (or simply flip the names - I would rather an away team be on the home side and vice versa than have the wrong people ANI THUS BACKWARDS FINAL SCORE under each side). Thanks

CHECK BOTH SCORESHEETS

We run an item like this every season, and sometimes more than once. And here it is again because it's often needed repeatedly. When you are signing scoresheets at the end of the night, it is up to you to make sure that they match. If the other team turns in a sheet without your ASP or fast game or something, it really sort of doesn't exist... In RDL, not on the sheet = didn't happen.
