- **Tournament matches start at 7:00 p.m.!!! Plan accordingly!**
- **In the tournament, failure to field at least 4 players by 7:15 p.m. will result in forfeit of the match. (Note: teams are not allowed until the 8:15 p.m. time used in the regular season.)**
- **NO MATCHES ARE ALLOWED TO CHANGE VENUE!!!! Relocated matches will be ruled double forfeits!!**
- All points are decided in a best-of-three format (except 1001).
- old ADO rules on diddles = winner of the coin toss determines throwing order in the 1st game, loser of first game decides in 2nd game, loser of original coin toss decides in 3rd game.

Make sure that any members of your team that are in the running for either of these awards play enough games if they are interested in trying to win either of those categories. [And please note that minimums for players on teams that received forfeit wins are lowered accordingly for both singles win percentages and all-star point averages. See page 4.]

...that each team member must play in 4 matches during the season to participate in the tournament. That number is 4 matches for all teams in all divisions, regardless of forfeits, byes, dropped teams, or whatever. You simply must throw in 4 matches. Four. No more... just four.

"A" Div. = 4.5 or more ASPs; "B" Div. = 4.0 or more ASPs

"C, D" Divisions = 3.5 or more ASPs

"E, F" Divs. = 3.0 or more ASPs; "G" = 2.5 or more ASPs

Also, we will list any fast games, high ins, high outs, or other amazing feats that you think warrant a little recognition (e.g., Ins & Outs higher than a Ton, 24-dart cricket games, 15-dart 301s, 24-dart 501s, Ton-70s and up, 5-Bulls+, etc.).

*Extra note: it's also ok to call in "fast games" in each set, even if they don't necessarily meet the maximum dart counts above.*

### SEASON-LONG TROPHY DART MINIMUM GAMES PLAYED REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for all-star point ave. & singles win %-age awards, you must play at least 66% of this season's projected games:

**TEAM DIVISION TITLE POSSIBILITIES IN WEEK 14, plus notes on who can still lock in a "top-two finish" as well**

[Note: These possibilities are written on the assumption that an unfortunate set of penalties (read: ineligible players?) doesn't crop up and change things. And also on the assumption that we don't have any exotic match scores like 8-7 or something like that...]

**A Division:** The Global Element and The Bullies are the top two teams, and they play each other. Winner is 1st, loser is 2nd. Simple as that.

**B Division:** Why So Serious?, Put It on Matt's Tab, and Blindsided are all 9-4, and Serious and Blindsided play each other, so somebody is getting to 10-4. Matt's Tab will end up in a point race with one of those two, either for 1st or for 2nd depending on whether they also win. Uber Out can jump into the race for 2nd also, if they win and Matt's Tab loses. In the event of season point ties, here is who holds the edge in each tiebreaker. Matt's Tab > Serious; Matt's Tab > Blindsided; Matt's Tab > Uber Out; Serious > Uber Out; Uber Out > Blindsided. Should a three-way tie for 2nd result, Matt's Tab takes it.

**C Division:** Show Me Your Tips takes 1st, unless they lose, and Trippin gains 18 or more points on them. If Trippin wins but fails to gain that huge amount on Show Me, then Trippin is 2nd. If Trippin loses, any and all of Stumble Out, Darty Sanchez, and Nine Lives could pass them with even the smallest of wins. If there end up being season point ties in the race for 2nd (with Trippin losing and any of the next three winning), here is who wins each tiebreaker: Sanchez > both Trippin and Niners; Trippin > both Stumble and Niners; Niners > Stumble; and if Stumble and Sanchez end up tied, they are in an exact dead heat and would have to play an extra match prior to week 15!! And if there ends up being a 3-way or 4-way tie in points, we'll just have to figure all those specifics out later...

**D Division:** Off Constantly-Reboot is 1st unless they lose, and the Bandits outscore them by 17 or more this week. Bandits are at least 2nd with a win, and would still be 2nd with a loss, if Menace also lost, or if Menace won but didn't gain even a single point on the Bandits.

**E Division:** Bad Mutha Duckas and Hump Day! are the top two. If one wins and one loses, the finishing order is obvious. But if they both win or both lose, it's Ducks 1st if Hump Day gains 6 or fewer points on them, it's Hump Day 1st if they gain 8 or more points on the Ducks, and if Hump Day gains exactly 7 points... it's a perfect tie and they would play an extra match before week 15 for the division crown!

**F Division:** Ton 80 Proof is 1st if they win, but is also 1st if they lose and the Village Idiots fail to gain at least 13 points on them. The Idiots are at least 2nd if they win. If the Idiots lose, then Sofa Kings can take 2nd if they win.

**G Division:** Rippin Darts is 1st if they win, but is also 1st if they lose and Runs with Corks fails to gain at least 18 points on them. The Corks are at least 2nd if they win. If the Corks lose, then Nein Mark can take 2nd if they beat the Corks by at least 5 points. But if Nein beats the Corks by exactly 4 points, we have yet another perfect dead heat, and Nein & the Corks would play an extra match before week 15.

**PREDICTIONS FOR THE WEEK**

A moderate 14-9 last week, plus I picked up the missing week 12 result, so we're "up to" 191-106 (64.3% correct) for the season. Doesn't feel like I'm really "up to" anything with that kind of record. Bummer.

**Match of the week:** (A Div.) The Bullies @ The Global Element. Well, of course this is the match of the week... month... season... year... era. This pairing has quickly become possibly the most evenly-matched, highest-talent pairing in the history of the RDL. And it's one match for it all... again. And it will likely be 1001... again. I have to take my Element!

**Match #2:** (B Div.) Why So Serious? @ Blindsided. Ohmigosh, that wk12 forfeit by Serious to the 6th place team (likely 7th if they had played). I'm saying Serious takes this, 14-10, but that's likely not enough.

**Match #3:** (G Div.) Nein Mark @ Runs with Corks. This is pretty close

to a straight-up head-to-head for 2nd place. But why just "pretty close"? Because Nein wins 13-11, and that's just barely not enough.

**Matches #4 & #5:** (E Div.) Bad Mutha Duckas @ Death Throw; Sharky's Machine @ Hump Day! This is "probably" a point race between the Ducks and Humpers, but their opponents aren't to be overlooked here - ya know, since they both won seven weeks ago. The Ducks survive, 15-9; but I don't think Hump Day does, 13-11.

**Match #6:** (B Div.) Boom Baby @ Put It on Matt's Tab. Matt's Tab has been in 1st place exactly zero days this season (and was often down in 4th). That could end with a big win here. Tab, 16-8.

**Matches #7, #8 and #9:** (C Div.) Double In Stumble Out @ Trippin Bulls; Show Me Your Tips @ Darty Sanchez; Rif Raf @ Nine Lives. Yeah, technically, these matches decide the C winner. But more than that, they collectively decide who will finish 2nd. Stumble Out starts the drama with a 13-11 win over Trippin. Then Show Me barely eliminates Sanchez in a 1001 tiebreaker. Then the Niners down Rif Raf 14-10 to fall just one point behind Stumble Out's season total!

**Match #10:** (A Div.) Consistently Inconsistent @ Darty Minds. Two teams who know the honor and value of a spot in A fighting for the auto-A-slot in the Fall. Love this. Darty has been hot, 13-11.

**Match #11:** (G Div.) Punk in Drublic @ We're Sexy & We Throw It. Yep, we finally have one head-to-head match for "that title". Not really sure how Punk is here, so I'll go with them in this one, 14-10.

## RDL TRIVIA

Last week's question: *This past week, we had both a match forfeit and a late scoresheet penalty. What are the records for the lowest numbers of forfeits in a season, and the lowest number of penalties in a season (at least during my tenure as RDL statistician, 1996-present)?*

Answers: Let's start with the forfeits... After looking up all the digits, I admit that I was a little surprised by how many forfeits we've actually had. This is my 53rd season as the statistician (with one season ended after week 8, and this season not quite complete yet), and we've had 311 regular season forfeits, for an average of 5.87 forfeits per season. Some of the larger number seasons are obviously driven by a team or two that forfeits out, who then subsequently has at least a handful of automatic forfeits attributed to their records. In the end, the highest number of forfeits in a season was 18 (in Fall 2008), followed by a season with 15 (Fall 1997), and three seasons with 14 each. The lowest number of forfeits was actually 0, and that has happened only TWICE (Spring 2001, Spring 2022), followed by 5 seasons with 1 forfeit each.

Now for the penalties... in the first 42 seasons I was here, there were literally dozens of penalties worth hundreds of points in most seasons. But then a few factors started filtering in, including electronic submission of scoresheets, skipping the fifth week captains' meetings some seasons, not always requiring election ballots in the election years where no more than one person ran for each office, and eventually texting of scoresheet photos. We had a pretty clear decrease in penalties starting with the Spring 2005 season, and then again starting in about Spring 2013. But it was in Spring 2018 that penalties really started getting rarer!! In the past 9 seasons (which include both the 8-week Covid season and the current not-quite-complete season), we've had only a total of 35 penalties for 454 points (and a match win or two). And the lowest ever (which was actually tied with the shortened Sp20 season, but that's not the same) was the Spring 2022 season. In that season, F division's Backpfeifengesicht picked up a 16-point late scoresheet penalty in week 3, and that was the entire sum total of penalties for the season. Only full season ever with fewer than 3 penalties.

This week's question(s) (the last of the season): **If you flip on over to page 9, you will see that Robbie Phillips of The Global Element is hanging out in some pretty rarified air in terms of ASP Average (this despite how few turns per game he actually throws!). In light of that, what is the RDL ASP Average record for a season?**

Name the band/singer? the song? Last week's answers: Song 1 = "Dead & Bloated" by Stone Temple Pilots; Song 2 = "Stressed Out" by Twenty One Pilots; Song 3 = "Magic" by Pilot. And the theme? Clearly, this one is all about the pilot here. Which is who I should be traveling with pretty soon. Wooow!! [Either nobody got more than one of these this week, or more likely, nobody who had more than one sent in their guesses. Most impressive to me was Pete Rutten getting Magic, as I was pretty sure that was the tough one of the group. But my favorite of the week was Allen Smith coming to our match and not singing Dead & Bloated, but also sharing his concert story remembrance of what he said was one of the best concerts he has ever seen. And that, ladies and gentlemen, is one of the reasons we play this game.- JK]

### "BLOCKER" REMINDER TO ALL TEAMS

Please remember that if a team leaves a slot blank and then an unlisted player (or players) comes in before that game is called, an unlisted player MUST be picked for the open slot. If more than one unlisted player has come in before the open slot is up, then the opposing team will select which of those unlisted players will play, but it MUST be one of the unlisted players. AND... (and this is important) players listed in this fashion are NOT blockers and DO register points for their teams.

### THE END OF A GAME

A quick reminder as we head into the divisional tournaments where the atmosphere is ratcheted up a bit: (as per ADO rules) the game ends when the dart that sufficiently scores to end the game is thrown; subsequent darts thrown are ignored. This means that if your second dart leaves 0 by hitting a double and you continue and throw your third dart anyway, the game was over before you threw the third dart and you have not busted by continuing.

### TOURNAMENT RESULTS / UPDATES

The VoiceMail system has been gone for years, so we obviously don't put the tournament pairings there each week anymore. I will still, however, be emailing out the updated tournament brackets each week. So all the league members (and associated others) on the email list will have weekly updates and I also suspect league webmaster Matt Ridgway will probably post the updated brackets on the RDL website as well.

### PERPETUAL PLAQUES

Don't forget: RDL offers 'perpetual plaques' for all fast games, ins/outs, & perfect throws (as well team regular season wins, if you want). They're large boards that hold multiple plates. 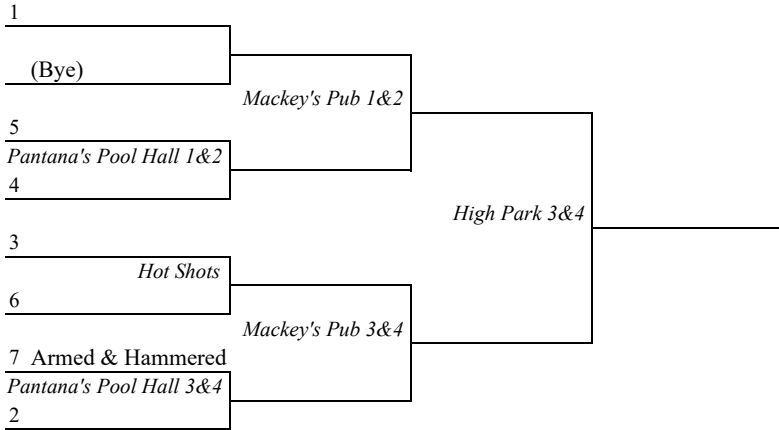
