TWO IMPORTANT NOTES AS WE HEAD INTO SPRING 2024

Several factors affected divisions again this season... many new teams... three B teams folded... etc. Thus... this standard notice...

As is relatively common (especially when the team number is changing, such as during the progression back from a pandemic-fueled lull), teams form, teams return, etc. And if an expanded number of teams that form/return have clear lower-end or clear higher-end talent, that situation necessitates pushing the team stack up or down a bit more than might have been expected by some teams. Thus, you might be in a higher division this season than you expected - rest assured that this was not an error, but rather is a response to team formation dynamics.

And Tons emails are going to change in the coming weeks...

It won't happen immediately (so that nobody is caught off guard), but in the near future the style of the weekly Tons emails will be changing. Rather than attaching the Excel and pdf versions directly to the emails, the weekly email will contain links to the newsletter within the league website. Won't take a lot more on your end than to follow the link to get the Tons, but didn't want you to think it was spam when that starts.

A LIST OF RECENT IMPORTANT REMIINDERS

FAILURE TO INCLUDE "BLOCKER" NAMES

In games with a shorthanded team (and thus, one or more "blockers"), failure to list the names of all competitors in those games will bear a consequence for BOTH teams. If the submitted scoresheet is missing names, BOTH teams will receive a 5-point penalty.

RESCHEDULING? MAKE SURE I KNOW ABOUT IT

Failure to notify the statistician of a rescheduled match in the proper timeframe is now a 16-point penalty for each team.

FORFEIT ETIQUETTE

If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us all an easy favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.

THROWING AFTER BUSTING IS ILLEGAL PRACTICE

Continuing to throw darts after clearly busting your turn is now officially against RDL rules. Obviously, if you hit a wire and didn't realize a dart was in, etc., changes the situation. But continuing to chuck away will be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct and is subject to the ladder of warnings/penalties that can come with those issues.

WHAT SCOREKEEPERS CAN SAY DURING CRICKET

It is now official RDL policy that during cricket, the scorekeeper may only tell the thrower how many of each number has been hit during this turn, and may not report any more of the situation (whether a number is now closed, new point total, points still needed, etc.).

PLAYING THE WRONG OPPONENT

I was going to paraphrase what happens when people don't pay attention and go to the line and play the wrong person, but I think this one is just easier if I copy the rule here: "f) If a player plays a game on the wrong board (resulting in playing the incorrect opponent) regardless of when the error is discovered, if the entire match is not complete and the scoresheet signed, the game must be replayed. No statistics from the incorrectly played game are valid. If both players play on the "wrong" board but are playing the correct opponent, no action will be taken."

EARBUD/HEADPHONE USAGE AT MATCHES

This one still pops up now and then, but the ruling was made seasons ago... As of Fall 2017: players can wear earbuds/headphones during a match, while scorekeepers can not. Hilarious that the second part of that sentence even needs typing.

DARTCONNECT USAGE AT MATCHES

Please note the recent league rules pertaining to using DartConnect devices to keep score. They include what is/isn't allowed, and what it takes to "agree" to use the device. Find them in these sections:

MATCHES.F.1 [page 5 of 12 in the rules], and

MATCHES.F.4.b.5 [page 6 of 12 in the rules]

HANDLE BUSINESS BEFORE WEDNESDAYS...

If you want to add a player(s) to your roster, they cannot play until they are approved and their dues are paid. And those additions and/or changes cannot be done on Wednesdays (even during the day on Wed.), as the Membership Director and Treasurer both have their matches to play that day as well.

SCORESHEETS

You have 3 copies in your team packet. Clearly, you'll need to make some copies for the remainder of the season. Don't forget.

SCORESHEET RETURN DEADLINE

The weekly deadline for submission of your scoresheets is no longer the end of Saturday. **The new deadline as of the Fall 2017 season is 11:59 p.m. Friday** (unless you had a rescheduled match - then it's within two days of whatever day you played).

1001 PARTICIPANT LISTING IS MANDATORY

Inclusion of the player names for all 1001 participants for BOTH teams on the scoresheet is mandatory! Failure to include those names will incur a penalty equal to a late scoresheet mailing penalty. There is even a box on the front of the scoresheet for names!

ROSTER UPDATES AND SPELLING

Please note: rosters provided in this preseason packet include only players added prior to Jan. 14th. Later additions will appear on the team statistics pages beginning in week 2. Also, please check the spellings and phone numbers from your roster listing - note any changes on your scoresheet or send me an email.

HOSTING TOURNAMENT MATCHES

It is the responsibility of the CAPTAINS (not the RDL board) to ensure their host bars are informed of the tournament schedule when it is released around weeks 12/13. A recent rule provision allows host bars to opt out of the tournament rotation, if they want to be done with darts after the regular season. However, they must notify the membership director by week 5, if that is the case.

"HOT DARTS" LISTING GUIDELINES

Here are the guidelines that will be used for the minimum number of all-star points each week for the "hot darts" page.

"A" Div. = 4.5 or more ASPs; "B" Div. = 4.0 or more ASPs

"C, D" Divisions = 3.5 or more ASPs

"E, F" Divs. = 3.0 or more ASPs; "G" = 2.5 or more ASPs

Also, we will list any fast games, high ins, high outs, or other amazing feats that you think warrant a little recognition (e.g., Ins & Outs higher than a Ton, 24-dart cricket games, 15-dart 301s, 24-dart 501s, Ton-70s and up, 5-Bulls+, etc.).

Extra note: it's also ok to call in "fast games" in each set, even if they don't necessarily meet the maximum dart counts above.

SEASON-LONG TROPHY DART MINIMUM GAMES PLAYED REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for all-star point ave. & singles win %-age awards, you must play at least 66% of this season's projected games:

for Divisions "A", "C" and "D" (7 teams / division):

Singles win %-age: min. of 16 Singles Games Played

All-star pt. Average: min. of 32 Total Games Played

for Divisions "B", "E", "F" and "G" (8 teams / division):

Singles win %-age: min. of 19 Singles Games Played

All-star pt. Average: min. of 37 Total Games Played

SEASON-LONG PREDICTIONS

JK's Standard Disclaimer : Rosters will change multiple times after I've written this, but that's out of my control. So, I go forward with some guesses every season. I could say nothing and let you wonder how ridiculously little I know about our talent levels, or I could do this, and remove all doubt. Wouldn't want to leave you wondering, right? (And yes, I get the schedules from Membership Director Heather Bohanan early enough to do separate week 1 picks nowadays, but you can probably glean most of those from this column...)

"A" Division: The Bullies sent a key member to pro darter land. Element sent key member to a back surgeon. Why So Serious added a couple excellent shots and bulked up a bit. And Darty Minds is back in A where they probably belonged in the first place. Feels like A is tightening up a little here. That said, there is still an incredible pile of talent on the usual suspects here, and this will likely look kind of similar to what people are used to seeing. I will take Element just barely ahead of Bullies, with the super dangerous Fringe and Liver right behind them. Then I have to go with the more-Serious-than-before, Darty, and Show Me. Excellent group.

"B" Division: Oh, look at Consistent adding some guns and switching the name up a bit. Meanwhile, Raging Bulls Eyes lost a couple guys so they hybridized with Uber Out to make what is almost a new team. Matt's Tab still has the same talent, and Stumble Out is looking for their next step in what could be a real ladder climb sequence. I think in the end, I have to go with Consistent, who will edge out Dart Attack. Stumble Out, Matt's Tab, and Raging all look to be serious title competitors, and I'm going to list them in that order for now. For Kids, who can beat any team here, will drop a few inexplicable ones, and will come in just ahead of the Bandits and Niners (who I'm not predicting to be exactly 0.500 for the first time in a while).

"C" Division: Aside from Rif Raf losing a key guy, this division appears to be one of the most static roster-wise compared to last season. Theoretically, that means I should do better in my predictions in this division than in others. So why does it never work out that way? Despite knowing that what seems obvious really just is not, I will take Sanchez to outrun The Outlaws (in what sounds like some sort of classic Western), with Hump Day and McGavin as the likely top chase duo. Off Constantly will come in just ahead of Rif Raf then (who is actually a bit more of a mix with some of the old Uber Out, I realize now), leaving Menace as my cellar team. And that last fact alone makes me think this entire set of picks is probably crap...

"D" Division: And now comes the part of the column where we encounter our first truly new team, and She-Unit's disparate prior divisions, time since last playing, etc., make them a really difficult team to slot here. Beyond them though, aside from the Rangers losing a core guy, the division looks to be consistent from the Fall.

Based on that fact, I'm guessing there won't be a whole lot of surprises here. But since most of these teams were about 0.500 or a little better in their divisions last season, I also think this will be a bit messy. Reload is going to take it over DD-214, with the Machine, Ton 80, She-Unit, the Idiots, and Rangers rounding things out. But if you told me this finished the exact reverse, I would only be slightly surprised.

"E" Division: Oh, ouch, no Som Samaluk for the Ducks? Super bummer. Nobody else here experienced a loss anything like that, and in fact, most of these teams look to be pretty much what you would expect. With the team stack moving up because of the team turnover, this is really quite a remarkable panorama of teams, drawing from all of D, E and F from last season. The comparison between them are pretty interesting and difficult to tease out, so I think this race is one of the most intriguing. Let's shake things up and take one of last season's F teams... I'll go with Dart Side, followed by Cheap Shots, the Possee, Irish Ton, and then Death Throw. Then let's say the Ducks outlast Cork and Bangin. And I have to say... while I've mocked a couple of my other picks above, this is the set in which I have the least confidence.

"F" Division: The only team here from above F last season was a winless E team that then split into two and each picked up a bunch of new players. Hard to expect those to be my top options, right? The wild card among the rest is Shark Shooters, who loaded up on weapons, but some of them haven't always been the most regular attendees. What do I do with that? Well, I pick them to win, that's what. We'll just hope the new guys show up "enough." But wait, there's a second wild card... Triple Shot and their new trio as well! Let's slot Triple Shot in second, just ahead of Sofa Kings and Rippin, followed by Zero Dart, Nein Mark, and Coach's Last Dance. I'm leaving the Dartifacts at the bottom here, but several of these guys played quite a bit many years ago, so they are yet another wild card who could finish much higher.

"G" Division: G has a few brand new teams, one that slimmed down to the bar minimum, and a few that have been around for a while. Big guesses with pure unknowns here, but I'll take She Said as the only thing that feels at all certain in this race. I'll guess that the rest will go Dart Knights, Bottoms Up, Killer Dee's, We Throw It, and then some coin tosses... Dart Vader's, 21 Dart, and Darts and Crafts?

THE PAGE OF INFORMATION THAT I RUN EVERY SEASON...

This is the place where I remind all of you of several things so that you can't say "I didn't know that" later on when you screw up. Sort of takes the blame off me if any of these bad things happen... which I sort of consider to be a good thing...

Some of these things change over the years, some don't... but please read them again.

This stuff is really important for the smooth flow of our nights out with our hobby.

COPIES OF COMPLETED SCORESHEETS

Keep a copy - it's as simple as that. I could give you all the reasons why, but I've done that a hundred times. Just **keep a copy of your sheet**, even if you lose, because you just never know when one of them will be lost by the postal service or your opponents. Hey, it has happened in twenty-five of the last thirty-eight seasons...

EMAILED TONS OF NEWSLETTER - UPDATED SP24

We have been emailing the Tons of Newsletter for many years now. And we will, of course, be continuing that this season (although it should be noted that in the very near future, the format of those emails will be changing, changing from an attachment in the email to a link to the newsletter on the RDL website). You don't need to do anything to stay on the email list if you were already on it, as the list carries over from season to season. If you would like to be removed from the list, simply email me back and let me know. If you weren't on the list and you would like to receive it, just email my address listed on page 4 and I'll add you to the list. All you need is a relatively recent version of either Microsoft Excel or a PDF Reader like Adobe Acrobat, based on which file version you want to read. Oh, also, you need to not be a whiner, or an ass, or just difficult to like). I generally send the Tons (or, in the near future, the link to the Tons) out in the range of Sunday to Tuesday. Sometimes it's earlier, and every so often a super busy week might instead push it back to Wednesday morning... but generally it will come in the Sunday to Tuesday window. [And on a related note, it has been many seasons since we offered hard copy issues (aside from the pre-season and banquet issues), and there is no expectation that we would return that system any time soon (or probably ever).]

SIMPLE TRUTHS THAT YOU SHOULD NEVER FORGET

1. Any player who plays in a match without properly registering and paying dues (register with the League Membership Director, pay the League Treasurer) prior to throwing is an ineligible player. Playing an ineligible player will cost your team its win (if you did indeed win), all game points from that match, and all statistics from that match, regardless of how well or poorly that ineligible player did.
2. Any player who doesn't play in any of the four primary sets of the match, but plays in the 1001 tiebreaker is an ineligible player - see number 1 (above) for the horror of this mistake.
3. Indicate which players of both teams took part in 1001 games on the front of the scoresheet. This is now MANDATORY, and allows us to check for ineligible players, record statistics, etc.
4. If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us a favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.
5. Wednesday player additions are not allowed. It turns out that Board members have dart matches too, so all roster additions are required to be completed no later than Tuesday for any player to play in that week's match.

MANY SCORESHEET RETURN PATHS AVAILABLE - BUT NOT ENTIRELY THE SAME AS IN RECENT YEARS

We have three routes remaining for turning in your scoresheets..

First, you can use your scanner (or your phone in some cases) and email me an image of the sheet (my email addresses are in the Tons every week and also on the back of the scoresheet)

Second, you can shoot me photos of your scoresheet if you want to take care of returning it immediately! Just make sure you have good lighting, you're close enough to the sheet, and it's IN FOCUS. (note: out-of-focus or overly dark photos will not be acceptable... duh). And you can send those photos by email or text (as with my email addresses, my phone number is on the scoresheet back).

Finally, you can still use the old school U.S. Postal Service. My address is also on the back of the scoresheet, but I caution you... I predict that this system will go away before too long (as I haven't received one via this route for a couple years now... plus the duration of a pandemic!).

[Quick note if you do actually decide to send me a hard copy via the snail mail side of things. Buying a (\$1.55-ish?) certificate of mailing could prove to be a nice piece of evidence if your scoresheet ever gets lost in the mail. Do NOT send your scoresheet by certified mail - I do NOT want to have to go to the post office repeatedly (or at all, to be honest) to sign for your scoresheets.]

If you use any of the modern electronic methods, I'll even email or text you a quick confirmation of receipt (since I'll have your email address or phone number, of course) - thus eliminating any worry about whether the sheet got through to me :o).

NO CALL-IN REQUIREMENT FOR MATCH RESULTS

As of the Fall 2017 season, winning teams are no longer required to call in match results each week. And actually, the league is now at the point where we have discontinued the VoiceMail number. Not enough use of it to warrant the cost any longer.

TEAM NAMES ON YOUR SCORESHEETS

Every season there are several instances of teams listing the team names on opposite sides of the scoresheets (meaning that one team's name is written above the other team's players). Obviously, I will eventually figure these out when the names under a team name aren't on the roster, but it would be cool if you simply indicate the error in some way (or simply flip the names - I would rather an away team be on the home side and vice versa than have the wrong people ANI THUS BACKWARDS FINAL SCORE under each side). Thanks

CHECK BOTH SCORESHEETS

We run an item like this every season, and sometimes more than once. And here it is again because it's often needed repeatedly. When you are signing scoresheets at the end of the night, it is up to you to make sure that they match. If the other team turns in a sheet without your ASP or fast game or something, it really sort of doesn't exist... In RDL, not on the sheet = didn't happen.
