Included below on this page is a list of very important reminders for you to keep in mind during the divisional tournaments. There are also reminders relating to the banquet, as well as to the Fall 2024 season. Please check them out.

TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY

Unlike in many previous years, simply having your dues paid is no longer enough for a player to be eligible to play in the postseason tournaments. Now a player much also take part in 4 regular season matches. Please note the far right column on page 10 for your division to see who is/isn't eligible for play in your tournament matches (players with 4+ are eligible). There are 33 players that are tournament-ineligible: 2 in A division, 6 in B, 2 in C, 6 in D, 5 in E, 7 in F, and 5 in G [plus the players in D and G no longer on rosters].

FINAL DIVISIONAL STATISTICS

Final statistics are available for all 7 divisions in this issue of the Tons of Newsletter, as all scoresheets have been received already. Please check your entire team's statistics for accuracy. **If there are any discrepancies with any of your team's statistics, and you want a recheck of the records, I'll give everyone through this Sunday (April 28th) to let me know about them. After that, all statistics will be considered FINAL.** That way, the trophy shop can have sufficient time to fill our rather large order. Thanks.

- "A" Division: Robbie Phillips owns 1001 with a 180 and a first-dart double to claim a less-intense-than-usual (at least for most folks) Element-Bullies match; Serious romps to ten cricket points over Show Me in a fight to claim the #5 slot and avoid a 'bottom-two'
- "B" Division: Dart Attack handles Consistent to complete the season's most dominant run; 6 of 8 B teams end 0.500 or lower
- "C" Division: Hump Day inexplicably leaves four of their best throwers at home on title-decider night, fall to Constantly in 1001; McGavin rolls Rif Raf, slides to title despite recent 4-3 run
- "D" Division: Reload, Rangers and DD-214 finish strong, ending D season with 4 of 7 teams winning at least 2/3 of their matches
- "E" Division: Bangin takes out shorthanded division winners to escape the E cellar; Irish take last 501 from Ducks in a direct face-up game to decide who has a bottom-two season finish
- "F" Division: Zero rips Rippin to complete undefeated regular season; Sharks win, barely hold off Sofa Kings for #3 spot

- Tournament matches start at 7:00 p.m.!!! Plan accordingly!
- In the tournament, failure to field at least 4 players by 7:15 p.m. will result in forfeit of the match. (Note: teams are not allowed until the 8:15 p.m. time used in the regular season.)
- NO MATCHES ARE ALLOWED TO CHANGE VENUE!!!! Relocated matches will be ruled double forfeits!!
- All points are decided in a best-of-three format (except 1001).
- ADO rules on diddles = winner of the coin toss determines throwing order in the 1st game, loser of first game decides in 2nd game, loser of original coin toss decides in 3rd game.

Last week's question: *(Let's update a question that we have run a few times over the years... well, decades now... that we last ran in the Fall 2016 season, I think) What is the greatest number of 1001s a team has played in a season (plus tournament)? (And as per usual, I can only answer this from Spring 1996 forward, as that is the amount of time I have been the statistician. League records before that point in time were, shall we say, a bit less granular.)*

Answer: In the nearly eight years since we last visited this category, we have had five teams (only one of them since the Sp19 season) find themselves in five 1001s during a single season+tournament span. And those five join the prior thirteen teams over the years that played five tiebreakers, with all eighteen of them tied for second place. That one team sitting above them is Constantly Corked from Spring 2012's B division, who lived through a stunning SIX tiebreaker legs (going 3-3, including a 1001 loss in the B tournament semifinal). Related side note... that same team also posted one of the eighteen 2nd place totals just 4 seasons later. Drama city with those guys. (Will Inconsistently Consist., Trips Are For Kids, Double In Stumble Out, Shooter McGavin or Bangin The Wire, this season's current leaders with 4 each, join at least the runner-up crowd with some extra legs in the tournaments?)

TOURNAMENT PREDICTIONS

Well, that was a STRONG end to the season for me! 21-3 (with another match dumped to a forfeit), and my three incorrect picks were a 13-11 and two tiebreakers (with one my losers shorthanded). Coulda been a perfect end! That brings me to 255-93 (73.3% correct) for the season, finishing in the 0.417 to 0.500 range with only four confusing teams.

"A" Division: While A division has gradually become more and more talented over the years, once this goes to best-of-three, I see the lines a little more clearly here. In the end, I think this bracket will go straight chalk, with the Element-Bullies final again being the showcase event.

"B" Division: This is the part where it would be fun and edgy to pick against the team that won their season most comfortably. But since I'm not a fool, we're soooo not doing that. There are some real 'upset-possible' opponents in this bracket, but in the end, I think the only win against the seeds will be Consistent taking out Stumble in the semis.

"C" Division: Ok, now HERE is a bracket where a lot of outcomes are possible. Lots of good teams, wild attendance variations, nothing is guaranteed. I'm thinking the top four will be the semifinalists ("think" being the key word), and then Hump Day will top Outlaws in what I think is the real C final (!). Constantly tops McGavin in the other semi.

"D" Division: Ok, four teams in D dusted the others, so they just have to be the semifinalists, right? Probably not, but I'm going with it. And then it's super-duper game on. Break Time is the place to be on semis night... ANY of these four can win, and these could all be tiebreakers in the semis and finals. I'll go with... Reload over DD in the finals?

"E" Division: The Corkers are super interesting, but I trust them 0%. Bangin is super dangerous, but they've let me down repeatedly too. What feels like it could be a pretty interesting set still somehow has me saying the top four move on, then the top two move on, and then the top one moves on. Chalk. Man, that feels really really dicey, at best...

"F" Division: Geez, the Sharks and Sofa, and of course Rippin, all have strong players. And yet, this feels completely over. Welcome to the Zero Dart Ton 80 Invitational. I will honestly be pretty stunned if this division also doesn't fall perfectly along seeds. This one feels the most likely to hold to form of any in this list. (Which means it won't be.)

"G" Division: Oh, the G race got soooo good throughout the season. And now there are four teams set to duke it out, AND they still need to pay big attention just to get out of round one. This is no longer your grandpa's slow old G division - this is one of the most exciting brackets here. Top four advance, then it's Killer Dee's over Bottoms in the final!

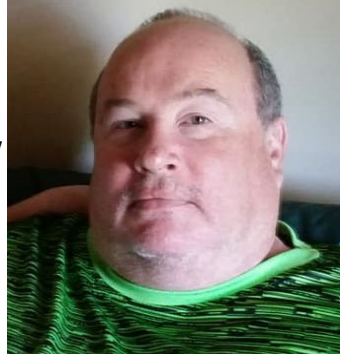
Dark Horses: Every team in C, every last one of them. Death Throw in E. And the Killer Dee's in G (is it still a Dark Horse if they're my pick??).

Surest things: Dart Attack in B. Zero Dart Ton 80 in F. Shockers there, eh? F having no upsets. And the usual Element-Bullies final...

The RDL suffered another crushing loss just over a week ago. Longtime RDL fixture **Steve Witz** passed on April 17th, shortly before his team's week 13 match.

Witz joined the RDL in the Fall 1997 season with Cheap Shots, the team that would become his main dart family for the next 27 years. (At least, I "think" that was Steve's first season. It was certainly his first season in the era when I was statistician.) Witz played his first 11 seasons with Cheap Shots, then joined Scott Butters and Dazed & Confused for 1 season before returning to Cheap Shots for another 5 seasons through the Spring 2006 season. After that, Witz made the jump to seriously competitive darts, playing the next 13 seasons with the teams captained by Mike Seward & Kenny Persson in A division, playing a key role in several A title winnings. After a brief stint away in 2013-2014, Witz returned to RDL to play another 19 seasons with Cheap Shots (playing as recently as just 7 days before his passing). In addition to being part of some A division title winners, Witz was named to a divisional all-star team 10 times, and was the B division MVP once as well. Steve was truly RDL, through and through.

While the memorial service hosted by Steve's family was already held, his team may organize a separate more dart-centric memorial at a future date. If/when I receive that information, I will share it via the email list.



WHO DIDN'T PLAY?! One of the clearest ever?

Some seasons this is one of my favorite items - the one where I report which individual leaders sat out sets in the final week. Although we can never be certain of the reason that somebody sits out, I'm sure we all have our guesses, and knowing who to guess about is lots of fun.

Many recent seasons have had pretty diverse sit-out reasons and outcomes. From sitting out to avoid losing, to sitting out and costing yourself a shot at the minimum games, to being absent and losing out, to being absent and gaining from it, recent seasons have had most everything. And this season, in addition to a couple of ticky-tacky little nothing items and a painful absence, we have... well... I will just let you read it and decide for yourself how high up the all-time list the last one listed here ranks.

Ok, let's start this with an examination of the ASP average leaders, as that section holds three of the four chapters here. First is our nothing burger... one of the women's ASP leaders was absent, but she was way ahead, so... yawn, nothing to see here. Next up is a pretty painful one, as Bethann Freeman of 21 Dart Salute sat out SCkt in week 14, and actually ended up losing the award - if she had hit any one ASP in that SCkt set (which is the ASP-maker set, of course), she would've taken the women's G Mug. Bummer.

And the last in this segment is another painful one that probably couldn't be helped, but ended up agonizing just because of how close things ended. Tim Bunn of Hump Day! was absent in week 14, and he got passed for the D ASP Mug by 0.009 per game. Maybe he holds on and maybe he doesn't, but it's going to hurt seeing how close that ended up being.

Which all brings us to the only singles race to ponder... Thorbjorn Gylfason of Rippin Darts in F division entered the week tied with Guy Howes, and playing in the same match. After Howes lost in 301 and Gylfason didn't, it's almost surely a coincidence that Gylfason sat out SCkt, right? His first missed game in any set this season... against the one opponent where his team most needs him. Hmmm, unlucky timing, surely. So unlucky that it's the first set he has missed during a match when he wasn't fully absent for the night in four and a half seasons - dating back to week 7 of the Spring 2022 season, the season he and his team joined the RDL. At least whatever the issue was remedied quickly enough for him to return for both doubles sets... phew. :o)
