A FEW NEWS CLIPS FOR THIS SEASON

Yep, those board numbers (on page 10 and on the player lists) are... correct

For the first I can remember, we have teams that signed up for board pairs that "partially" overlap other teams' board pairings. Happened with boards at both Snooker's and the newly added Back Then. And Membership Director Heather Bohanan is such a bad ass that she just rolled with it and solved all the schedules for everybody anyway, even with their board weirdness. But bottom line? The board numbers are right.

We lost a couple blind draws

There is a list of blind draws on page 4 every week (except it's page 8 in the banquet issue each season). If you look closely, you'll see that the list has two fewer than we had at the end of last season. I update that list all season, so if you get updated info on one, please share!

Updated league rules document

There are a couple updated rules this season. All captains got a new copy at the preseason meeting (and I posted one on the website).

A LIST OF RECENT IMPORTANT REMIINDERS

FAILURE TO INCLUDE "BLOCKER" NAMES

In games with a shorthanded team (and thus, one or more "blockers"), failure to list the names of all competitors in those games will bear a consequence for BOTH teams. If the submitted scoresheet is missing names, BOTH teams will receive a 5-point penalty.

RESCHEDULING? MAKE SURE I KNOW ABOUT IT

Failure to notify the statistician of a rescheduled match in the proper timeframe is now a 16-point penalty for each team.

FORFEIT ETIQUETTE

If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us all an easy favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.

THROWING AFTER BUSTING IS ILLEGAL PRACTICE

Continuing to throw darts after clearly busting your turn is now officially against RDL rules. Obviously, if you hit a wire and didn't realize a dart was in, etc., changes the situation. But continuing to chuck away will be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct and is subject to the ladder of warnings/penalties that can come with those issues.

WHAT SCOREKEEPERS CAN SAY DURING CRICKET

It is now official RDL policy that during cricket, the scorekeeper may only tell the thrower how many of each number has been hit during this turn, and may not report any more of the situation (whether a number is now closed, new point total, points still needed, etc.).

PLAYING THE WRONG OPPONENT

Rather than paraphrasing what happens when people don't pay attention and go to the line and play the wrong person, I'm pretty sure this one is just easier if I copy the rule here: "f) If a player plays a game on the wrong board (resulting in playing the incorrect opponent) regardless of when the error is discovered, if the entire match is not complete and the scoresheet signed, the game must be replayed. No statistics from the incorrectly played game are valid. If both players play on the "wrong" board but are playing the correct opponent, no action will be taken."

EARBUD/HEADPHONE USAGE AT MATCHES

This one still pops up now and then, but the ruling was made seasons ago... As of Fall 2017: players can wear earbuds/headphones during a match, while scorekeepers can not. Hilarious that the second part of that sentence even needs typing.

DARTCONNECT USAGE AT MATCHES

Please note the recent league rules pertaining to using DartConnect devices to keep score. They include what is/isn't allowed, and what it takes to "agree" to use the device. Find them in these sections:

MATCHES.F.4.b.5 [page 6 of 12 in the rules]

HANDLE BUSINESS BEFORE TUESDAY NIGHT...

If you want to add a player(s) to your roster, they cannot play until they are approved and their dues are paid. And those additions and/or changes must be COMPLETED by 9 pm Tuesday each week. The Membership Director and Treasurer both have their matches to play each week, so all roster changes must finish by the day prior.

SCORESHEETS

You have 3 copies in your team packet. Clearly, you'll need to make some copies for the remainder of the season. Don't forget.

SCORESHEET RETURN DEADLINE

The weekly deadline for submission of your scoresheets is no longer the end of Saturday. **The new deadline as of the Fall 2017 season is 11:59 p.m. Friday** (unless you had a rescheduled match - then it's within two days of whatever day you played).

1001 PARTICIPANT LISTING IS MANDATORY

Inclusion of the player names for all 1001 participants for BOTH teams on the scoresheet is mandatory! Failure to include those names will incur a penalty equal to a late scoresheet mailing penalty. There is even a box on the front of the scoresheet for names!

ROSTER UPDATES AND SPELLING

Please note: rosters provided in this preseason packet include only players added prior to Aug. 4th. Later additions will appear on the team statistics pages beginning in week 2. Also, please check the spellings and phone numbers from your roster listing - note any changes on your scoresheet or send me an email.

HOSTING TOURNAMENT MATCHES

It is the responsibility of the CAPTAINS (not the RDL board) to ensure their host bars are informed of the tournament schedule when it is released around weeks 12/13. A recent rule provision allows host bars to opt out of the tournament rotation, if they want to be done with darts after the regular season. However, they must notify the membership director by week 5, if that is the case.

"HOT DARTS" LISTING GUIDELINES

Here are the guidelines that will be used for the minimum number of all-star points each week for the "hot darts" page.

"A" Div. = 4.5 or more ASPs; "B" Div. = 4.0 or more ASPs

"C, D" Divisions = 3.5 or more ASPs

"E, F" Divs. = 3.0 or more ASPs; "G" = 2.5 or more ASPs

Also, we will list any fast games, high ins, high outs, or other amazing feats that you think warrant a little recognition (e.g., Ins & Outs higher than a Ton, 24-dart cricket games, 15-dart 301s, 24-dart 501s, Ton-70s and up, 5-Bulls+, etc.).

Extra note: it's also ok to call in "fast games" in each set, even if they don't necessarily meet the maximum dart counts above.

SEASON-LONG TROPHY DART MINIMUM GAMES PLAYED REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for all-star point ave. & singles win %-age awards, you must play at least 66% of this season's projected games:

for Divisions "A", "B" and "C" (7 teams / division):

Singles win %-age: min. of 16 Singles Games Played

All-star pt. Average: min. of 32 Total Games Played

for Divisions "D", "E", "F" and "G" (8 teams / division):

Singles win %-age: min. of 19 Singles Games Played

All-star pt. Average: min. of 37 Total Games Played

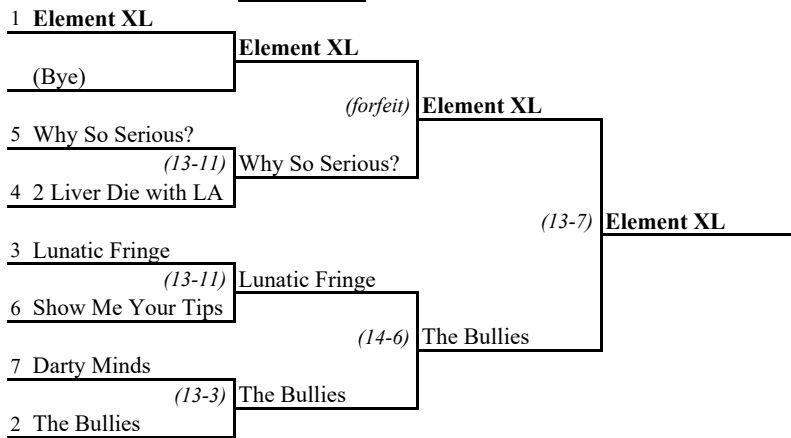

SEASON-LONG PREDICTIONS

JK's Standard Disclaimer : Rosters will change multiple times after I've written this, but that's out of my control. So, I go forward with some guesses every season. I could say nothing and let you wonder how ridiculously little I know about our talent levels, or I could do this, and remove all doubt. Wouldn't want to leave you wondering, right? (And yes, I get the schedules from Membership Director Heather Bohanan early enough to do separate week 1 picks nowadays, but you can probably glean most of those from this column...)

"A" Division: Alright, the biggest news of the fall season is the absence of The Bullies. They were 50% of the best and most talented rivalry in league history, and life circumstances have ended their run all too soon. But we will revisit The Bullies and their history in a future issue (because teams like that deserve a bit of tribute). What's left is... still a lot of talent. Element is likely to continue just being Element, so I have to go with my own team. Fringe and their shiny new Jimmie Jones (sure, he won't play much... right) are pretty clearly a finalist now, followed by Talladega Flights. But after that, I think there is going to be a furious battle for 4th. Show Me Your Tips (with a nice DiMichele pickup) will likely just outpace Dart Attack (who is NOT your normal "team up from B" and who I think could be here awhile), and then Why So Serious (minus Vic White) and Stumble Out. *And one more thing on this race... I have a side note on this season's A division lineup in the right column for you to read and consider...*

"B" Division: Oh, man... there are two huge pickups in this division if they really are going to be showing up and playing. Kevin Foushee and Jerry Oakley?? Hell, yeah, sign 'em up. Serious A championship history in that pair. Aside from a bit of a loss for Sam's Brother's Tab (Dave Tanner), the rest of these lineups are pretty consistent this time around. I will assume Foushee plays, so he and his brother take Darty Minds right back to A. Pretty sure Consistently Inconsistent will join them, as they'll slot in ahead of Hump Day (and their new Oakley), Me In The Hall, and Raging. Then will come Sam's Brother's Tab and Shooter McGavin, I think.

"C" Division: I think it's possible that I might have been picking The Outlaws here anyway, but then they went and added Mike Denton. Denton hasn't been a "full" full time guy in the past few seasons, but even half time should be enough to bolster The Outlaws to title levels. In the fight for second, I think I'll go with the Bandits, but this race is going to be nuts. The Niners are right there, as are The Village Idiots (and a very nice Dave McEwen addition), and Off Constantly (assuming that Q-Ball fills enough of the now-missing Angelo Azevedo time). But that leaves Sanchez and Mulligan's Mafia at the bottom?! Oh yikes, those teams could win C. I can already pretty much see that this division is going to just nuke my correct pick rate...

"D" Division: And now we get to the division that might look the least like last season in terms of roster consistency. Wing & A Plaque made a couple nice pickups. Is that B.Cool on the Possee or a different newer Brian Coleman? Dart Side is half different. And Irish Ton made three huge additions. This division is a whole new world, and a super tough call. I guess I'll go with Wing & A Plaque, and then I'm taking a huge flyer on Irish Ton (with two new Butterworths and a Frederick). They will be followed by the Rangers, Ton 80 Proof, Menace, and Rif Raf. Then I suppose I'll drop Possee and Dart Side toward the bottom, mostly because of roster turnover.

"E" Division: And right after the roster change messiness that was D, we have... the relatively consistent set of E teams. Generally, that should mean I do well here, but I see it more as a lack of excuses for what is almost sure to be a poor set from me. I'm going to guess that this is just the next rung on the Dirty Darts' ladder up the RDL standings, and they'll be pushed by the Machine. The Corkers are looking at about a third place spot, outrunning Death Throw and Rippin. And then of course, there's Cheap Shots, who fool me continually and could well go 1-1 against every opponent, who will outrun Bangin (the only E team with much roster turnover).

"F" Division: In a division where several teams experienced a key loss or two, the Ducks went the other way. A long way the other way, adding back Som Samaluk. And poof, just like that I'm taking the Ducks to take the F title. And then I'm going with a pick that will likely surprise the team itself, as I'm going with Bottoms Up in 2nd! Next we'll take Sofa Kings, then Shark Shooters (who lost Jon Strickland), Armed & Hammered (which is about 40% a different team), Nein Mark, That's What She Said (who lost Doug DiMichele), and then Coach and his Enya collection.

"G" Division: Which brings me to G, with one new team and at least five team with important roster losses. Ouch, babe. Which makes this a super tough set of picks to offer up here. No Mike Lamb, no Terron Amos, no Pat Schaefer, no Matthew Bailey, several missing Triple Shots... yikes. I'm taking... We're Sexy & We Win G! Dart Knights bounce back to a 2nd place spot, ahead of Triple Shots, Heart of Dartness, and then Bright side of Flights (yep, a team with 0 wins ever so far!). I'll then go with I Got Your 6, The Dartifacts, and 21 Dart Salute to round things out.

THE PAGE OF INFORMATION THAT I RUN EVERY SEASON...

This is the place where I remind all of you of several things so that you can't say "I didn't know that" later on when you screw up. Sort of takes the blame off me if any of these bad things happen... which I sort of consider to be a good thing...

Some of these things change over the years, some don't... but please read them again.
This stuff is really important for the smooth flow of our nights out with our hobby.

COPIES OF COMPLETED SCORESHEETS

Keep a copy - it's as simple as that. I could give you all the reasons why, but I've done that a hundred times. Just **keep a copy of your sheet**, even if you lose, because you just never know when one of them will be lost by the postal service or your opponents. Hey, it has happened in twenty-five of the last thirty-nine seasons...

EMAILED TONS OF NEWSLETTER - UPDATED FA24

We have been emailing the Tons of Newsletter for many years now. And we will, of course, be continuing that this season, in a sense - each week, I send a link to the RDL website with a notification that I've posted the new newsletter there. All you need is a relatively recent version of either Microsoft Excel or a PDF Reader like Adobe Acrobat, based on which file version you want to download. Oh, also, you need to not be a whiner, or an ass, or just difficult to like - if that's you, you'll just have to keep checking the website yourself, as I will certainly remove you from the weekly reminder list.

Beyond just generally not sucking, you don't need to do anything to stay on the email list if you were already on it, as the list carries over from season to season. If you would like to be removed from the list, simply email me back and let me know. If you weren't on the list and you would like to receive it, just email my address listed on page 4 and I'll add you to the list.

I generally send the notice of a new Tons in the range of Sunday to Tuesday. Sometimes it's earlier, and every so often a super busy week might instead push it back to Wednesday morning... but generally it will come in the Sunday to Tuesday window. [And on a related note, you can also download past issues (and even historical compilations!) anytime from the league website.]

SIMPLE TRUTHS THAT YOU SHOULD NEVER FORGET

1. Any player who plays in a match without properly registering and paying dues (register with the League Membership Director, pay the League Treasurer) prior to throwing is an ineligible player. Playing an ineligible player will cost your team its win (if you did indeed win), all game points from that match, and all statistics from that match, regardless of how well or poorly that ineligible player did.
2. Any player who doesn't play in any of the four primary sets of the match, but plays in the 1001 tiebreaker is an ineligible player - see number 1 (above) for the horror of this mistake.
3. Indicate which players of both teams took part in 1001 games on the front of the scoresheet. This is now MANDATORY, and allows us to check for ineligible players, record statistics, etc.
4. If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us a favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.
5. Wednesday player additions are not allowed. It turns out that Board members have dart matches too, so all roster additions are required to be completed no later than 9pm Tuesday for any player to play in that week's match.

MANY SCORESHEET RETURN PATHS AVAILABLE - BUT NOT ENTIRELY THE SAME AS IN RECENT YEARS

We have three routes remaining for turning in your scoresheets..

First, you can use your scanner (or your phone in some cases and email me an image of the sheet (my email addresses are in the Tons every week and also on the back of the scoresheet)

Second, you can shoot me photos of your scoresheet if you want to take care of returning it immediately! Just make sure you have good lighting, you're close enough to the sheet, and it's IN FOCUS. (note: out-of-focus or overly dark photos will not be acceptable... duh). And you can send those photos by email or text (as with my email addresses, my phone number is on the scoresheet back).

Finally, you can still use the old school U.S. Postal Service. My address is also on the back of the scoresheet, but I caution you... I predict that this system will go away before too long (as I haven't received one via this route for several years now... plus the duration of a pandemic!).

[Quick note if you do actually decide to send me a hard copy via the snail mail side of things. Buying a (\$1.50-ish?) certificate of mailing could prove to be a nice piece of evidence if your scoresheet ever gets lost in the mail. Do NOT send your scoresheet by certified mail - I do NOT want to have to go to the post office repeatedly (or at all, to be honest) to sign for your scoresheets.]

If you use any of the modern electronic methods, I'll even email or text you a quick confirmation of receipt (since I'll have your email address or phone number, of course) - thus eliminating any worry about whether the sheet got through to me :o).

NO CALL-IN REQUIREMENT FOR MATCH RESULTS

As of the Fall 2017 season, winning teams are no longer required to call in match results each week. And actually, the league is now at the point where we have discontinued the VoiceMail number. Not enough use of it to warrant the cost any longer.

TEAM NAMES ON YOUR SCORESHEETS

Every season there are several instances of teams listing the team names on opposite sides of the scoresheets (meaning one team's name is written above the other team's players). Obviously, I will eventually figure these out when the names under a team name aren't on the roster, but it would be cool if you simply indicate the error in some way (or simply flip the names - I would rather an away team be on the home side and vice versa than have the wrong people ANI THUS BACKWARDS FINAL SCORE under each side). Thanks

CHECK BOTH SCORESHEETS

We run an item like this every season, and sometimes more than once. And here it is again because it's often needed repeatedly. When you are signing scoresheets at the end of the night, it is up to you to make sure that they match. If the other team turns in a sheet without your ASP or fast game or something, it really sort of doesn't exist... In RDL, not on the sheet = didn't happen.
