Included below on this page is a list of very important reminders for you to keep in mind during the divisional tournaments. There are also reminders relating to the banquet, as well as to the Spring 2025 season. Please check them out.

### TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY

Unlike in seasons years ago, simply having your dues paid is no longer enough for a player to be eligible to play in the postseason tournaments. Now a player much also take part in 4 regular season matches. Please note the far right column on page 10 for your division to see who is/isn't eligible for play in your tournament matches (players with 4+ are eligible). There are 20 players that are tournament-ineligible: 5 in A division, 2 in B, 5 in C, 1 in D, 3 in E, 3 in F, and 1 in G [plus the 3 players in G no longer on rosters].

### FINAL DIVISIONAL STATISTICS

Final statistics are available for all 7 divisions in this issue of the Tons of Newsletter, as all scoresheets have been received already. Please check your entire team's statistics for accuracy. **If there are any discrepancies with any of your team's statistics, and you want a recheck of the records, I'll give everyone through this Sunday (Nov. 24th) to let me know about them. After that, all statistics will be considered FINAL.** That way, the trophy shop can have sufficient time to fill our rather large order. Thanks.

## AND OUR RECENT TOURNAMENT WINNER TRADITION

If your team is fortunate enough to make its way to your divisional tournament final, don't forget to be ready to take a team photo if you win the Mugs. We've been running a gallery of tournament-winning team photos for several seasons now, and people kinda love putting faces to the names sometimes (even just in the vein of "oh, THAT'S who that team is... cool").

## TOURNAMENT PREDICTIONS

For the second week in a row (and fourth this season), we dumped another match to forfeit, leaving only 24 on record last week. I went a decent 17-7 in that week, bringing my season total record to 237-108 (68.7% correct). I was able to drag my C pick rate up to 47.5% by the end of the season, but that's honestly pretty awful. And there were six teams that fooled me more often than not this season, and to the surprise of roughly nobody, four of those six uber-confusing teams were in C division. Duh. Anyway, let's fire off some guesses about the divisional tournaments - and yep, once again I'm picking every round through every tournament before any results at all are reported.

**"A" Division:** Ok, it's really tough to pick against an undefeated team (especially when it's my own team), so... I won't. I'll take Element here. It's after that things get WAY more interesting, as the next four teams are all fully capable of a run. Somehow, in the end though, I think this bracket is going to completely hold to seedings in each round.

**"B" Division:** With all due respect to the other teams here, this one is nearly over already. Darty Minds is an A team in B clothing. If the Inconsistents can overcome their expectedly inconsistent attendance, they are certainly going to join them in the finals (and likely in A next season). In The Hall and Hump Day round out another chalk bracket.

**"C" Division:** Geez, The Outlaws sure limped to this season crown, coming within four darts of an 0-4 finish. But EVERY other team in this division has a losing DCKT record, so I still have to take them. The Mafia will be in the finals with them, but both of the other quarterfinals will both be going to the lower seeds (Nine Lives and Off Constantly).

**"D" Division:** Unlike some season winners (like The Outlaws in C), Wing just felt like they were getting bigger separation from the pack every week. So I'm sooo taking Wing here. Rif Raf will meet them in the finals, but their quarterfinal with Irish Ton might be the best match in this bracket. Possee and the newly dangerous Menace make the semis.

**"E" Division:** I don't care about the late season slip-up or the continual rise of a couple of the contenders... just move Dirty Darts up now and save us the time. After that, Bangin The Wire and Rippin Darts have been hot and move on, with Bangin making the final (and yes, this will be the Dirty Bangin final). Cheapies outlast Corks in the other quarter.

**"F" Division:** Hey, could the Bottoms have made the second half of their run any less confidence-inspiring? One score in seven weeks over 14? I guess I'll take them because they are super-strong top four, but it's without high conviction. The Ducks will see them at the end, and the #5 and #6 seeds (Shooters and Armed) each haul in a quarters win.

**"G" Division:** The top four in G made for a great race this season, and they all get together (well, in two locations) in the semis again. Dart Knights ride their DCKT dominance by Dartness, but then they drop the final to Your 6 and their four-pack of dominance since Jose joined in.

**Dark Horses:** Talladega in A, basically the entirety of C division, and Armed & Hammered in F division (and actually several other F teams).

**Surest things:** Darty Minds in B. Wing & A Plaque in D. Dirty Darts Done Dirt Cheap in E. The top four in G moving into a semis melee.

## RDL TRIVIA

Last week's question: *There was a period when the RDL gave out separate Mugs for divisional '01 ASP Average winner and Cricket ASP winner. For how many seasons did we split the two ASP categories, and when was it? Also, what percentage of the divisions in those seasons had the same person win both ASP Mugs?*

Answer: The RDL split the ASP Average into separate '01 and cricket categories for a span of 5 seasons, from Spring 2007 through Spring 2009. The first of those five seasons had 7 divisions, while the other four of those seasons each had 8 divisions; that means there were 39 total divisions contested under the umbrella of the split ASP categories. And of those 39 divisions, 16 of them (41%) gave both ASP category Mugs to the same person. 5 of 7 divisions in Sp07, 2 of 8 in Fa07, 2 of 8 in Sp08, 4 of 8 in Fa08, and 3 of 8 in Sp09, each crowned the same person twice. And it happened in every division at least once in those five seasons except H division. (Side note: we also gave split ASP Mugs to the top woman in each category in each division in those five seasons, but that data is much less instructive. There were no women in 10 of those 39 divisions, several more divisions had no women who played enough games to qualify for one Mug or the other or both, several more only had one or two qualifying women, and one division gave out no '01 Mug because none of the women had thrown a Ton that season.)

## WHO DIDN'T PLAY?! Another interesting one...

Some seasons this is one of my favorite items - the one where I report which individual leaders sat out sets in the final week. Although we can never be certain of the reason somebody sits out, I'm sure we all have our guesses, and knowing who to guess about is lots of fun.

Many recent seasons have had pretty diverse sit-out reasons and outcomes. From sitting out to avoid losing, to sitting out and costing yourself a shot at the minimum games, to being absent and losing out, to being absent and gaining from it, recent seasons have had most everything. And this season, we have a few ticky-tacky little nothing items, several pretty inconsequential sit-outs, and... well... I will once again let you read it and decide for yourself how high up the all-time list the last one listed here ranks.

Ok, let's start this with an examination of the singles win percentage leaders. There were only two things that registered at all, and neither seems to really warrant much attention. We had one person who was late and missed 301, but his team was actually shorthanded in their biggest match of the season, so that was soooo not intentional. And the other was a person who clinched without playing, but that was because the opponents forfeited - kinda hard to hold him responsible for that, eh?

Which brings us to the ASP average races, where there were quite a few more to check out. But in the end, "most" were hardly bell-ringers. We had one person way ahead in his race not play 501 in a match where the win was already clinched, and we had TWO instances of two division-leading teammates both sitting out 501. I suppose maybe they coulda played one or the other, but when they treat them equally, that's kind of a non-story.

But I did say it was only "most" that were hardly bell-ringers, didn't I? Turns out there WAS one that made bells go off a bit, at least for me. Bryan Hartley of Village Idiots, the C division ASP leader, had the oddest sequence of schedule conflicts this past Wednesday. Turns out he must not have been available in time to play 301, and then he also must have had to leave his match before 501! Those two games of '01 were the first and only sets Hartley didn't play this season. Heck, he hadn't been listed out of any set since the 301 of week 6 back in the spring. And the last time he had missed a 501 was week 9 in the fall of last year. What a fortuitous pairing of such timely schedule conflicts. And pretty lucky that the guy chasing him in the ASP race didn't have a big night and reel him in... but... oh, right... that guy had a bye, so I guess it would have taken an even crazier-big-night from a pursuer who was even further behind to start the night. Either way, phew!
