TOURNAMENT WINNERS

- "A" Division - Brave the Elements (13-3)**
Element completes an undefeated full 2024 year with a finals win that just kept tilting the close games their way, but the bigger hurdle was their semifinal escape (again!) from Dart Attack.
- "B" Division - Darty Minds (14-10)**
Darty gets pushed to the limit by Kilts In The Hall in the finals, but eventually completed their undefeated season/tournament double, after winning their regular season by the largest margin of any division champion this season (finishing 5 matches ahead!).
- "C" Division - The Outlaws (14-8)**
Nothing came easy (for roughly anyone) in C division this season. The Outlaws won the season title with the lowest win percentage in any division (0.750), they were outpointed by another team by 10 points, and this final score was their biggest tournament margin.
- "D" Division - Wing & A Plaque (14-6)**
After a regular season in which their supremacy was basically never really challenged, Wing ends up also claiming the Mugs without facing any opponent that also finished in the top half of the division during the season (facing the #8, #5, and #7 seeds).
- "E" Division - Dirty Darts Done Dirt Cheap (13-5)**
Dirty Darts rolled through their tournament in much the same way they rolled through their season, clinching matches earlier than most other teams every night. They ended up as the only tournament winner to never have stepped to the line for 501.
- "F" Division - Bottoms Up (14-4)**
The original team name that hilariously (and appropriately) started as the Rock Bottoms is a thing of the distant past, as the Bottoms climb Up once again, this time as the second tournament winner in this list to face no other top half team (#8, #5, #6).
- "G" Division - Dart Knights (14-4)**
The Jared Markham Farewell Tour pulls into its final stop at the G final at Sharky's Place, where the Knights run away from The Dartifacts (who were likely out of practice, as they had won their last THREE matches by forfeit - yes, including 2 in the tourney).

FALL 2024 TIEBREAKER SUMMARY

A bit less tiebreaker drama this season, with 32 of them (29 during the season, 3 in the tournaments). A division was next (6, with 1 in the tournament), followed by G (5), F (4), E (3, with 1 in the tournament), B (3), and then C (just 1).

8 teams played at least three tiebreakers, with all of those teams in A, D or G division. The extra leg champs were Liquor Posse in D, the only team to win three overtime games. The Cardiac Kids award goes to Irish Ton in D, who played FIVE 1001s, saving their only win in the five for their tournament quarterfinal(!). And the Heartbreak Award has to go to Dart Attack in A, who finished 1-3 in tiebreakers, including a loss in their tournament semifinal (honorable mention to 0-3 Ton 80 Proof in D).

And yes... I have confirmed that there will definitely be a blind draw on New Year's Day. And there will even be one literally on Christmas Day if there are enough people there with interest in playing one!! (Elyse Kenealy said she will already be there, so why not? Which is pretty much all the invitation most of our RDL dart addicts will need, I expect...)

AND DON'T FORGET THE REGULAR DRAWS TOO

While it appears that only the Upper Deck will be adding any "extra" draws during the weeks over the holidays, the Deck and four other area establishments will continue hosting their regular draws until the spring season starts (see full list on page 8).

OR MAYBE YOU WANT TO ADD ANOTHER LEAGUE?

Looking to add a second league this coming season? The list of options is evidently maybe still growing around here! Beyond the leagues in Durham and Chapel Hill, it looks like there might be a new cash long-format singles league in the area. Both the BCDL in Durham and the TDL in Chapel Hill should start up their next season at roughly the same time as the RDL, and the new singles league at the Upper Deck appears to be starting as soon as they determine how many people are interested. For the BCDL and TDL, I recommend that you visit their websites (listed below) periodically to get the most updated registration information for the upcoming seasons. For the singles league, you can find the starter information and contact address in a string on the RDL Facebook string.

Bull City Dart League (BCDL - Durham)

If you happen to be interested in trying out one of the very few handicapped steel-tip leagues anywhere, then the BCDL is for you. The BCDL spring 2025 season will be registering in early to mid-January, as the Fall season is about to end. Teams in the BCDL consist of 4-8 players, dues are \$25 per player per season (some of the host establishments cover half or all of those, so maybe ask around), and the home bars are primarily in RTP and the downtown Durham area. More complete information (and any updates in the coming weeks) can be found at:

www.thebcdl.org That website also includes a wealth of information about the league and its rules, so if you're just interested in seeing how the league applies a handicap system to a steel-tip league, you can find all of that there, including rules, statistics, and scoresheet examples.

Triangle Dart League (TDL - Chapel Hill & Durham)

The teams in TDL consist of 6-10 players per team, and dues are \$20/player per season (I think). Recent seasons have used bars in both Chapel Hill and Durham, but I suspect that might vary a bit from season to season based on team preferences & signups. Always check www.ibiblio.org/ncdarts/t dl/ for the most current information, but recent season registrations have been held at the Tavern in downtown Durham, and I expect registration for the spring 2025 season to be held in early to mid-January.

Pro-Development Singles League (PDSL - The Upper Deck)

Stevie Phillips is setting this one up, and he listed full specifics in the RDL Facebook string. In general, it will be divisions of six players, you play two matches per week for ten weeks, facing the others in your group five times each. Play will be on Tuesdays, matches will be all 501, and divisions will be stratified by player averages. Oh, and you must have a DartConnect account.

QUICK STAT TIDBITS

-The **Quadruple Double Award** winners (double-digit wins in all 4 sections): With only three divisions playing with a bye, I thought we might get a handful with 10+ wins in every set in any of D, E, F or G divisions. But nope, once again a very exclusive club this season. Only 7 players leaguewide even managed 9+ wins in every set, much less 10+ in each. There were an additional 3 more who managed 10+ in three of the sets, but all of those were in the 8-team divisions, so those aren't enough to name here. In the end, our Honorable Mentions are: **Mike Jones** of Dart Attack in A (four 9+ win sets in a 7-team division), **David Evans** of Bottoms in F (three 10+ win sets and a 9 win set), and **Terron Amos** of Dart Knights in G (three 11+ win sets and a 9 win set). But the real kings with all 10+ win sets are: **Mike Raquet** of That's What She Said in F division, **Marlin Brady** of I Got Your 6 in G division, and **Jerrell Swepson**, also of Dart Knights in G division (who actually had set win totals of 11, 14, 12 and 11!).

-**IronMan/Woman Award**: Three divisions (A, B, C) only played 12 matches, so obviously they're going to lag behind in this category unless something crazy happens. And things once again held to that predictable form... This season's IronMan is **Matt Furdon** of Heart of Dartness in G division with 59 games played. The honorable mentions for other division leaders included: **Zeek Lea** of Dart Attack in A, with 51; **Charles Tompkins** of Put It On Sam's Brother's Tab in B, with 51; **Kevin Olson** of Off Constantly-Reboot in C, with 49; **Mark Powell** of Red-eye Rangers in D, with 58; **Gary Burney** of Cheap Shots (again!) in E, with 58; and **Mike Raquet** of That's What She Said in F, with 57. It's actually pretty crazy how close those top numbers are, within A-C and D-F.

-The **Team Attendance Award** winners: Once again nobody came close to the six-thrower ironman standard this season. Several teams rode hard with seven throwers, but only three of them kinda sorta dropped to six for many of their matches this season. So those three will be honorable mentions in the absence of a true parallel to the old Burnt Weeny teams: Dart Attack in A division, One Armed Bandits in C division, and Heart of Dartness in G division.

MY PRESEASON, WEEKLY, & TOURNEY PREDICTION RESULTS

As usual, I'm left with the option of trying to bluff my way through this part, or just telling the truth. And since I know some of you squirrel away every last thing I've ever written about your team, I will again give real results... bummer. Sometimes these results can border on embarrassing...

In my preseason picks (usually the toughest every season given imminent roster changes/additions), I was a freaking monster! I picked 5 div. winners, and the other 2 I had in 2nd! In A division, I was literally one game, maybe one dart, from perfect. B was also nearly perfect. In C, I had a lot right, but I super duper missed Mulligan's Mafia. In D, I had a lot of things close, but I sort of flipped Irish Ton/Ton 80 with Rif Raf/Menace... not excellent, but not terrible. Then in E, I again got a lot right, but I had Machine and Death Throw much higher, with Bangin and Rippin much lower (especially Bangin). Next, in F, I flipped the top two, and I really undersold She Said, but the rest was great. And then there's G... I had the Knights in 2nd... we won't talk about the rest...

My weekly prediction results you can peruse pick-for-pick on the other side of this sheet of paper. As noted on that page, you are all fantastic human beings, except for C division. All of the people in C division suck, and I am convinced they conspired against me. Only the Outlaws seemed to refuse to fully buy in with the evil C plan. Anyway, in the end, I was 237-108 (68.7% correct) for the season. Not bad, but a little worse than other recent seasons.

Last but not least were my tournament predictions... Often when we jump to best-of-3, my picks get stronger, despite the fact that I'm picking semifinals and finals that I conceivably could have wrong before the matches are even played. This season, I did things backward from usual, starting out limping and then crushing at the end. I started only 16-8 in the quarterfinals (with the other three semifinalists advancing via byes), then I posted a decent 9-4 record in the semifinals. But then I nailed 6 of the 7 Mug winners! That takes me to 31-13 (which is over 70% correct, even with having to pick rounds in advance). Not too bad at all! [Note: we also dumped two tourney matches to forfeits.]

JK'S TEAM-BY-TEAM, WEEK-BY-WEEK MATCH PREDICTION RESULTS

(I introduced this page forty seasons ago, and it has become almost expected as a newsletter staple. Feast your eyes on the success...)

For several years, many of you have taken no greater pleasure in your weekly darting endeavors than to email or text me and point out to me just how wrong I was in my prediction of your match result. On a related note, I have noticed that many of you seem to have relatively selective memories saving only the weeks when I was wrong. Further, many others of you regularly embellish your statistics of how often you fool me. It's not so easy to get away with those rambles anymore, however, as you can see below. Each W is a week when I picked your match correctly, and each L is one I picked incorrectly. Division totals are to the right of the team totals, weekly totals are at the bottom, and in the space between the

I now run this column during seasons in which I've included trivia questions all season. Each question is listed exactly as it was during the season, so there is potential for a question to now be out of date, but it's usually not too much of a problem. Each question is listed under the week number when it ran, and the answers follow the questions. No peeking...

Week 7 question(s): This season already has three divisions without an undefeated team. During my tenure as statistician (1996-present, 56 seasons), what is the earliest week of the season when the league was left with no undefeated teams in any division?

Week 8 question: In honor of the awesome G race right now...

what is the lowest number of teams finishing above 0.500 in a division for a season (during my 29-year tenure as statistician)?

Week 9 question: Two weekends ago, the annual NC State Championships were held here at the Upper Deck. How many total state championship event titles have been won by current members of the RDL over the years?

Week 10 question(s): Since I took over as league statistician in 1996, we've had seasons with 6, 7, 8 and 9 divisions. Of my 56 seasons here, how many have had each of those numbers of divisions? And when was the last time each of those happened?

Week 11 question(s): How many different people have led the entire RDL in ASP Average for a season during my 55 prior seasons here as the RDL statistician? Who are they? And what is the record highest per game ASP Average in a season? (and of course, only throwers making the minimum game requirement for each season are considered for this question)

Week 12 question(s): What is the highest single-season ASP Average in my 55 prior seasons as RDL statistician? What is the lowest per game ASP average to lead the league in those seasons? And how many times has anyone in any season thrown an average better than that "lowest high" without being the top themselves?

Week 13 question: What is the lowest ASP Average to win the divisional season-long ASP Average Mug in each division (A-I) during my 55-season tenure as the RDL statistician?

Week 14 question(s): There was a period when the RDL gave out separate Mugs for divisional '01 ASP Average winner and Cricket ASP winner. For how many seasons did we split the two ASP categories, and when was it? Also, what percentage of the divisions in those seasons had the same person win both ASP Mugs?

Week 7 answer: This is a question that we have run a couple times before over the past 29 years, and it turns out the answer hasn't updated itself in quite a long time! That still-standing record for the latest the last undefeated team lost is week 7, and that has happened twice. In Spring 1998, Lunatic Fringe in A division and Top Dead Center in B division both entered week 7 undefeated, and both lost in tiebreakers. Then in the Spring 2009 season, Who's the Daddy? in A, Rif Raf in B, and the Overtime Outlaws in D all entered week 7 undefeated, with all three losing (14-10, 16-8, and 12+-12, respectively) that night. So, we've already passed the record week this season with four divisions still featuring an undefeated squad.

Week 8 answer: Ok, I wasn't quite sure what the answer to this might be when I posed the question. But now that I have the answer, I'm reminded of an amazing couple of instances. In my 55 prior seasons as statistician, there have been 405 divisions contested, and an amazing 51 of those have had two or fewer teams with a winning record. Now, one of those was a shortened 8-team A division race in the Covid-truncated season, so that one isn't as impressive. But there have been 29 divisions with 7 teams over the years that only had two winning teams. And more impressive than that, there have also been 19 divisions with 8 teams that had only two with winning records (and that doesn't count the Covid-shortened one). But none of those is the record... The record is shared by the Fall 1999 D division and the Spring 2002 B division, each of which included 7 teams and produced only ONE team in the division above 0.500. In the Fall 1999 season, 12-0 Get The Point won D ahead of FOUR teams at 6-6. And in the Spring 2002

season, D.V. Needed won B with only a 10-2 record, ahead of a tight pack of three 6-6s, two 5-7s, and one 4-8. [Side note bonus answer: FOUR seasons over the years have included at least three divisions at once with only two winning teams in them. Fall 2001 A/B/D divisions, Fall 2017 B/D/E divisions, Spring 2018 A/B/C divisions, and then in Spring 2003, there were FOUR divisions (B/C/D/G) fitting that category!] [Answer update for the banquet Tons: This season we added a 20th division with 8 teams that had only two with winning records, as D division joined that club.]

Week 9 answer: In the 33 state tournaments held in the 35 years since the tournament began, 198 different people have shared the 687 total event titles (when you count each person as a titlist, as in doubles produces 2, triples produces 3, etc.). And 22 of those 198 people are current RDL members, with a grand total of 113 of the event titles among them (16.4% of all event titles to date).

9 people have 1 each (Kyle Gaulthier, Simon Healy, Tony Horton, Michael Johnson [who we are counting in our numbers because he is the dang President], Chad Massengill, Jerry Oakley, Allyson Blackwelder, Petra Mozzetti, Tisha Taylor). Deborah Blackwelder, Nicole Kubel, and Samantha Wilson have 2 each. Mike Hall and Allen Smith have 3 each. Michelle Stacy has 4. Jimmie Jones and Mike Seward have 5 each. Wil Tan has 6. Stevie Phillips has 8. Phillip Eastmead has 10. Tom Brown has 19 (tied for 4th most ever). And Robbie Phillips is tied for the most ever with 35!!

Week 10 answer(s): In my 56 seasons here, only 5 of them featured only 6 divisions (with the last occurring in the Fall 2021 season as we were coming out of the Covid pandemic, and that was the only time since the Fall 2005 season). There have been 27 seasons featuring 7 teams (with the last obviously being the current season). There have been we seasons featuring 8 divisions (with the last of those coming back in the Fall 2019 season - which is not technically the last play before the pandemic, as we had half a season in Sp20 also). And finally, we've had exactly 1 season with as many as 9 divisions (with that one membership explosion coming in the Spring 2010 season - a season that somehow had 8 more teams than the prior season, and 4 more than the season after).

Week 11 answer(s): In my 55 prior seasons as statistician, a total of 18 individuals have led the RDL in ASP average for a season. 10 of these 18 each led the league for a single season (Stef Bogaerts, Jim Davis, Phillip Eastmead, Pat Gibson, Phillip Maxwell, Dan Naylor, Jerry Oakley, Somchai Samaluk, Allen Smith, Bob Terry). 3 more people have led the league for two seasons each (J.D. Dixon, Mike Seward, Alex Spellman), and 2 more people have led the RDL for three seasons each (Tom Brown, Wil Tan). Which brings us to the top three in terms of ASP Average seasons led. Jim Budelman led the league 4 times, and Brian Blake led the league 6 times. And then there is the king of basically everything here in RDL-land... Robbie Phillips (currently of Brave the Elements) has led the RDL in ASP Average a stunning TWENTY-THREE times (and he has only played 39 seasons in which he was here enough to make the minimum games requirement). The even crazier part? He has also finished 2nd 8 times. And all 8 of the other non-1st-or-2nd seasons were in 2007 and earlier (and even those "lesser" seasons included ones where he finished 4th-7th four more times). [Answer update for the banquet Tons: make it twenty-four times for Phillips. And if you want to see a bit more clearly how dominant his ASP lines have been, maybe flip over to page 18 for a quick perusal.]

Week 12 answer: The highest single-season average is a stunning 2.700 by Robbie Phillips in the Fall 2023 season. [And for those wondering how many times a thrower has gone beyond 2.6, the answer to that is three: Phillips in the aforementioned Fa2013...

... season (2.700), Phillips in the Fa2013 season (2.698), and Phillips in the Sp2013 season (2.630).] At the other end of this particular list, the lowest per game ASP average to lead the entire league for a season was the 1.500 posted by Wil Tan in the Sp2002 season (which was just below Somchai Samaluk's 1.570 leader in the Sp2001 season and Jim Budelman's 1.577 leader in the Sp2003 season). And finally, in my prior 55 seasons as statistician, there have been 216(!) players who have posted a season higher than that 1.500 season-leading total without leading a season themselves. Which means that there have been 270 seasons above 1.500 when you add in the other 54 season leaders. [Answer update for the banquet Tons : seven more throwers posted an ASP average above 1.500 this season (see pg. 30), bringing that total to 277 seasons over 1.500 in my 56 seasons as statistician.]
Week 13 answers : Ok, this is my 56th season as statistician, and we've had six divisions 5 times, seven divisions 27 times, eight divs. 23 times, and nine divisions 1 time. That means this we've had 56 A, B, C, D, E and F divisions during my time, we've had 51 G divs., we've had 24 H divisions, and we've had 1 I division. And the lowest division-winning ASP averages for a season in each are as follows: A div. - 1.500 (63.0 ASPs in 42 games) - Spring 2002 - Wil Tan - The Raleigh Llamas // B div. - 0.900 (40.5 in 45 games) - Spring 2018 - Hugh Vance - Traveling Beer Bellies // C div. - 0.774 (41.0 in 53 games) - Spring 1996 - Stephen Margets - Pog Mo Hon // D div. - 0.744 (32.0 in 43 games) - Fall 2012 - Tom Kubel - Blind Squirrels // E div. - 0.659 (27.0 in 41 games) - Fall 2005 - Bill Buckley

- Boondock Saints // F div. - 0.615 (32.0 in 52 games) - Fall 2021 - John White - Banging The Wire // G div. - 0.546 (29.5 in 54 games) - Fall 2000 - John Cox - Madhouse Patients // H div. - 0.538 (21.0 in 39 games), which is the lowest any-division Mug-winning average during my tenure - Fall 2015 - Keith Feller - Ballistic Behavior // I div. - 0.767 (33.0 in 43 games) - Spring 2010 - John Wilson - Mug Hunters (which is, due to the existence of only one I division ever, also the HIGHEST average ever to win I division :o).
Week 14 answer : The RDL split the ASP Average into separate '01 and cricket categories for a span of 5 seasons, from Spring 2007 through Spring 2009. The first of those 5 seasons had 7 divisions, while the other four of those seasons each had 8 divisions; that means there were 39 total divisions contested under the umbrella of the split ASP categories. And of those 39 divisions, 16 of them (41%) gave both ASP category Mugs to the same person. 5 of 7 divisions in Sp07, 2 of 8 in Fa07, 2 of 8 in Sp08, 4 of 8 in Fa08, and 3 of 8 in Sp09, each crowned the same person twice. And it happened in every division at least once in those five seasons except H division. (Side note: we also gave split ASP Mugs to the top woman in each category in each division in those five seasons, but that data is much less instructive. There were no women in 10 of those 39 divisions, several more divisions had no women who played enough games to qualify for one Mug or the other or both, several more only had one or two qualifying women, and one division gave out no '01 Mug because none of the women had thrown a Ton that season.)

We darters are an odd breed. How many times have you gone to a bar for a match and the following has been you? You walk into the bathroom, and it's exposed pipes, cracked porcelain, broken flusher handles, and a nasty sink with a loose roll of cheap paper towels... and you shrug and ignore it. *Like the last many seasons, we used three-song groups each week and also included a theme each and every week. Added a layer to the game for everybody and has been quite popular. **Here are the themes for each week**, including the week 14 twenty-song set that actually came with a pretty big hint this season, at least as far as what the theme would be.*

Week 2 theme: Well, this one's about not being in time, of course. If it happens to randomly come at the same time as several captains forgetting the many-seasons-old rule that roster additions have to be completed on Tuesday, then I guess that was just fortunate timing. Of course. Week 3 theme: I guess I must have had a sweet tooth when I was putting this set together. Sugar, Cake, Pie... sounds like a pretty good day. The pie is very obviously the far weaker part than the cake, but to each their own. Week 4 theme: Well, I thought we might just shake things up a little bit. Week 5 theme: A whole land of confused people, where everybody wants the power, and way too many people just don't think. Oh, it must be election season. That time of year when people remind me how unable they are to generate critical thought for themselves by blindly railing on unilaterally for whatever their particular party of choice is. Doesn't matter if what the party is espousing is fair, right, or even logical, just keep yelling, and if the others don't agree, just get louder and maybe call them some names. So many people just looking for a fight. On behalf of the minority of us in the middle who are willing to recognize that both sides get some things right and both sides get some things wrong... give it a rest, thoughtless lemmings. (Yes, I realize I'm typing into a vacuum here...) Week 6 theme: Bands/artists with exclamation points in their names. And yep, P!nk really does "spell" it with an exclamation point rather than an 'i'. I guess maybe you are supposed to pronounce it as PINK!! Or maybe she just did it so you could actually search her on a web browser even before she was huge. Week 7 theme: I just got back from a week in Vegas a few days ago. And while I do like spending time with all you guys, if I could turn back time about ten days and relive it all, I'm pretty sure I would pick that. So, let's just take a jump to the left... Week 8 theme: Pretty obviously, this set was all about being close. And it was crafted fully in honor of the G division race, which is characterized by close standings, close matches, close everything, on a weekly basis. Week 9 theme: Let's just say that recent events, of which some of you in a specific division might be aware :o), might have inspired a story of some headstrong people who might well have told each other things like 'blow me' and 'beat it.' Sometimes fictitious stories (or lyrics quizzes) are based in reality... Week 10 theme: Hmmm... I wonder if I watched someone being a baby last weekend at the NC City League tournament. Certainly "something" but baby thoughts in my head. :o) Week 11 theme: As stated so accurately by Paul Jacobi in his set of guesses this week... 'Hungry... Hungary... close enough.' Yep, that's exactly where I snagged the idea for the set. The Phillips brothers headed to the World Dart Federation World Cup in Hungary, and bingo, a lyric set was born. Week 12 theme: Sending me something... such as... a photograph. Of your scoresheet. On time. Or not on time, I suppose. Week 13 theme: Feeling the need to get away... escape... run away from something. There are lots of things that something might be, and more common in some weeks than others, I'm guessing. Week 14 theme: NFL teams (listed in the standard order of NFL standings used in news outlets).

IS THIS THE MOST INCREDIBLE DART ACHIEVEMENT I'VE EVER REPORTED HERE?

I've been here for a long time, and I've had the opportunity to write about some pretty incredible achievements. From the very brief (say, back-to-back perfect throws) to the extraordinarily large (members advancing to world level events on multiple continents). And there isn't really any truly objective way to compare those in terms of just "how extraordinary" they are, but sometimes you can just sort of feel the difference, I think. And I can just feel it here...

For those who don't know, the North Carolina City Dart League (NCCDL) is the statewide "league of leagues" that has competed for 30 years, with the idea being that each city sort of make its own league all-star team and send it to battle the other cities' teams. It's very popular and highly competitive. And **Robbie Phillips** (of Brave the Elements) has played for the Durham team for over two decades. And it's Phillips's singles run in that league that is the core of what I'm referencing. There are generally 7-9 roughly monthly matches in a season, plus 0 to 3 tournament matches in a single weekend per team, and each match has best-of-three sets of both 301 and cricket.

The extraordinary part here is Phillips's astonishing singles record, and the length of time from which I'm pulling a large number of the results. Let's get into some of the details...

--- Phillips has not lost a singles point since before Covid existed. His combined (301+cricket) singles record since the start of 2020 is 74-0. 74 wins and 0 losses. And in those 74 best-of three sets, he has dropped only 5(!) legs. His leg count in that span is 148-5!! People, half of these are friggin' 301, and all of these are against the very best players from across the state. That includes 18-0 (36-1 in legs) in the tournament, where the "matches against the best get even more distilled and concentrated." Also, don't forget that each

301 starts a match cold, generally after a month away from the board, so it's not like he gets on a hot streak and picks off ten opponents in a row. (And singles cricket only has 301 as a warm up... so in Phillips's case, he has generally thrown about maybe 25 competitive darts before singles cricket begins.)

--- But wait, there's more! Since the start of 2008, Phillips's singles record is... wait for it... 197-7 (397-42 in legs) in the regular season, and 72-7 (149-22 in legs) in the tournament, for a combined total of 269-14 in sets (546-64 in legs). That's a win rate above 95%! On average, he loses less than 1 time in 20 matches, against the best throwers the state has to offer.

--- In that 269-14 run since the start of 2008, only 8 people have beaten Phillips, with 6 people doing it once (Steve Chorba, Matt Eller, Keith Gibbs, Chris Hyde, Donavon Powell, and Michael Smith, with 4 of those 6 doing it before 2012), and only 2 people defeating him more than once. If Brian Blake (3 wins) and Dan Naylor (5 wins) weren't around, Phillips would have almost never lost. (And yes, Phillips has played the Wilmington players the most because of the decades-long Durham-Wilmington battle at the top of the state, so half of those 8 losses are indeed in tournament finals, and include one perfect throw per opponent in those lost sets.)

--- Quick side note before I finish up here... it's not like Phillips was some sort of slouch before 2008. In the span from 2004-2007, he was 33-9 in the regular season, and 12-4 in the tournament. Even before that, when he was first starting out from 2001-2003, he was 25-21 in the regular season, and 13-4 in the tournament.

So, whaddya think? I've run a lot of Phillips stats over the years. Is this one the most amazing? I might be voting for this one...

STATE MEETING RESULTS - SPECIFICS FOR 2025 SEASON

Ok, somehow this season's annual meeting was simultaneously one of the most productive AND least productive meetings in years. A great number of the small details for the year were glossed over or not even considered, a state championships location was voted on without seeing even one bit of either bid, and there was a good amount of in-fighting within some areas of the state. But somehow, we also greatly expanded both the NCCDL and NCLC team lists, we welcomed in several new associations and/or teams, and plans for the implementation of DartConnect as a league standard were started (albeit without a lot of the rule details that will be needed to cover possible situations yet). It was even put in place that the league would cover the 'per-team' DartConnect cost for year one (but no, not the cost of the tablets themselves). For the schedule of play, the captains decided to continue the every-other-year pattern and 2025 will be a "Mountain/Beach" and "Central" style. The NCCDL divisions will be: (7 teams) Asheville / Boone / Pineville / Charlotte / Jacksonville / Fayetteville / Port City, and (8 teams) Lake Norman / Greensboro / Piedmont / Chapel Hill / Durham / Wake Forest / Raleigh / Capital Area [note: the Greensboro and Piedmont teams are NOT the same association]. For the NCLC, there are no Boone or Fayetteville teams in the Mountain/Beach, but there is a Sneads Ferry; and there are no Lake Norman, Chapel Hill or Wake Forest in the Central, but there is Fuquay-Varina; thus, the NCLC has 6 teams in each division. So the NCCDL will have 15 teams, and the NCLC will have 12.

HISTORY OF THE NCCDL...

It was back in 1995 that Tim Lane (then the captain of the Raleigh NCCDL team) first introduced the idea of the statewide year-long season style of play to replace the old "one team holds the cup against a string of challengers" sytem. It's still possibly the most popular and successful idea ever for anything larger than a local league. Here are the 29 tournament final results so far:
