## SCHEDULING NOTE FROM MEMB. DIR. HEATHER BOHANAN

If you just look at the team names in the different divisions this season, you will think that I have been doing this too long and have lost my mind. However, that is not the case (at least not in reference to the seedings). I do not think we have ever had a season with more dramatic roster changes where teams kept the old names. This season we lost an A and B team. This loss is responsible for many of the "odd looking" seedings. A and B only had 7 teams last season so there had to be a bit of an "upfill" to keep them at 7. In addition, several of those A/B players joined friends on other teams from lower divisions, so a team that has the same name as it did last season may be significantly more skilled and so moved up. There are also some instances where a team may have moved up but the team immediately above them last season did not. That is because the team that was slightly higher last season lost a significant number of skilled players. Basically, you can't just look at the team names this season and make any sort of correct assumptions or conclusions. I know people will see these seedings and not look at the actual members of the teams and think "What the heck......" I look at every single person registered on every single team and note who did not return and who was added to try to make the most equitable divisions possible. And then I ask Jason to look at it, which he always graciously does. Just know that a lot of time and effort was put into this and don't react to just the team names.

## A LIST OF RECENT IMPORTANT REMIINDERS

## FAILURE TO INCLUDE "BLOCKER" NAMES

In games with a shorthanded team (and thus, one or more "blockers"), failure to list the names of all competitors in those games will bear a consequence for BOTH teams. If the submitted scoresheet is missing names, BOTH teams will receive a 5-point penalty.

## RESCHEDULING? MAKE SURE I KNOW ABOUT IT

Failure to notify the statistician of a rescheduled match in the proper timeframe is now a 16-point penalty for each team.

## FORFEIT ETIQUETTE

If you know your team is going to miss a match, do us all a favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!).

## THROWING AFTER BUSTING IS ILLEGAL PRACTICE

Continuing to throw darts after clearly busting your turn is now officially against RDL rules. Obviously, hitting a wire and not realizing a dart was in, etc., changes the situation. But continuing to chuck away will be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct and is subject to the ladder of warnings/penalties that can come with those issues.

## WHAT SCOREKEEPERS CAN SAY DURING CRICKET

It is now official RDL policy that during cricket, the scorekeeper may only tell the thrower how many of each number has been hit during this turn, and may not report any more of the situation (whether a number is now closed, new point total, points still needed, etc.).

## PLAYING THE WRONG OPPONENT

Rather than paraphrasing what happens when people don't pay attention and go to the line and play the wrong person, I'm pretty sure this one is just easier if I copy the rule here: "f) If a player plays a game on the wrong board (resulting in playing the incorrect opponent) regardless of when the error is discovered, if the entire match is not complete and the scoresheet signed, the game must be replayed. No statistics from the incorrectly played game are valid. If both players play on the "wrong" board but are playing the correct opponent, no action will be taken."

## EARBUD/HEADPHONE USAGE AT MATCHES

This one still pops up now and then, but the ruling was made seasons ago... As of Fall 2017: players can wear earbuds/ headphones during a match, while scorekeepers can not. Hilarious that the second part of that sentence even needs typing.

## DARTCONNECT USAGE AT MATCHES

Please note the recent league rules pertaining to using DartConnect devices to keep score. They include what is/isn't allowed, and what it takes to "agree" to use the device. Find them in these sections:

## HANDLE BUSINESS BEFORE TUESDAY NIGHT...

If you want to add a player(s) to your roster, they cannot play until they are approved and their dues are paid. And those additions and/or changes must be COMPLETED by 9 pm Tuesday each week. The Membership Director and Treasurer both have their matches to play each week, so all roster changes must finish by the day prior.

## **SCORESHEETS**

You have 3 copies in your team packet. Clearly, you'll need to make some copies for the remainder of the season. Don't forget.

## SCORESHEET RETURN DEADLINE

The weekly deadline for submission of your scoresheets is no longer the end of Saturday. The deadline since the start of the Fall 2017 season is 11:59 p.m. Friday (unless you had a rescheduled match then it's within two days of whatever day you played).

## 1001 PARTICIPANT LISTING IS MANDATORY

Inclusion of the player names for all 1001 participants for BOTH teams on the scoresheet is mandatory! Failure to include those names will incur a penalty equal to a late scoresheet mailing penalty. There is even a box on the front of the scoresheet for names!

#### ROSTER UPDATES AND SPELLING

Please note: rosters provided in this preseason packet include only players added prior to Aug. 2nd. Later additions will appear on the team statistics pages beginning in week 2. Also, please check the spellings and phone numbers from your roster listing - note any changes on your scoresheet or send me an email.

## HOSTING TOURNAMENT MATCHES

It is the responsibility of the CAPTAINS (not the RDL board) to ensure their host bars are informed of the tournament schedule when it is released around week 13. A recent rule provision allows host bars to opt out of the tournament rotation, if they want to be done with darts after the regular season. However, they must notify the membership director by week 5, if that is the case.

## "HOT DARTS" LISTING GUIDELINES

Here are the guidelines that will be used for the minimum number of all-star points each week for the "hot darts" page. "A" Div. = 4.5 or more ASPs; "B" Div. = 4.0 or more ASPs "C, D" Divisions = 3.5 or more ASPs

"E, F" Divs. = 3.0 or more ASPs; "G" = 2.5 or more ASPs Also, we will list any fast games (24-dart cricket games, 15-dart 301s, 24-dart 501s, or fewer), Ins or Outs higher than a Ton, or perfect or near-perfect throws (Ton-70s and up, 8m+, 5-Bulls+).

Extra note: it's also ok to call in "fast games" in each set, even if they don't necessarily meet the maximum dart counts above.

## SEASON-LONG TROPHY DART MINIMUM GAMES PLAYED REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for all-star point ave. & singles win %-age awards, you must play at least 66% of this season's projected games:

for Divisions "A" and "B" (7 teams / division):

Singles win %-age: min. of 16 Singles Games Played All-star pt. Average: min. of 32 Total Games Played for Divisions "C", "D", "E", "F" and "G" (8 teams / division):

min. of 19 Singles Games Played Singles win %-age: All-star pt. Average: min. of 37 Total Games Played



#### SEASON-LONG PREDICTIONS

JK's Standard Disclaimer: Rosters will change multiple times after I've written this, but that's out of my control. So, I go forward with some guesses every season. I could say nothing and let you wonder how ridiculously little I know about our talent levels, or I could do this, and remove all doubt. Wouldn't want to leave you wondering, right? (And yes, I get the schedules from Membership Director Heather Bohanan early enough to do separate week 1 picks nowadays, but you can probably glean most of those from this column...) "A" Division: Oh, just wow... A division is a whole new world this season. Tw

teams did some serious revamping/recruiting, and now there could be a three-team free-for-all reminiscent of some of the races in the late '90s. A couple other A teams made some very nice acquisitions as well, and somehow in the first RDL season I have ever experienced without Lunatic Fringe in the lineup, the talent and storylines are some of the best in a very, very long time. Let's start with the newly bursting contenders... Dart Vader (formerly Talladega) added a murderer's row of Jimmie Jones, Mike Jones, and Josh Curvin; meanwhile, Show Me added RDL legends Sid Mitchell and Tex Mozzetti. Defending champion Element returns in its same form, and it's game on for these three in a show of which I'm very glad to be a part. Darty Minds was already a stout fourth, and then Inconsistent added both Joel Eason and Roy Lee Lindsey, while Serious got a nice pickup in Zeek Lea, and the upcoming Outlaws have literally decades of A division and City Cup champion experience. In the end, I have to take my own Element (duh), but just barely ahead of Vader and Show Me. Darty will outrun Inconsistent, followed by Serious and The Outlaws. "B" Division: And here we have a second division already with some significan roster turnover. Hump Day very nearly could've ended up in A, so I'll take them here. Close behind will be the Village Idiots, mostly because they're really just some Raging Bulls plus the Idiots' best player. Wing & a Plaque is not only rolling up the ladder, but also added Mike Litzsinger, and they're in line for a top-three finish. Next will be a great set of battles between a slightly slimmed down Stumble Out, a very new look Dart Attack, the very dangerous Secrets (welcome to B, Mathews), and the Kids, who always seem able to beat or lose to roughly anybody on their schedule. "C" Division: A bit more stability in C, but a trio of nice pickups by teams the might have been expected to be lower end have really made this a tough call. I think I will take Shooter McGavin here, but admittedly with little conviction. The Niners and Mafia are who I think will be the primary competition, but really I wouldn't be surprised if any team here made a charge. The Bandits are always dangerous, Sanchez has a recent habit of winning, Rif Raf made a nice Gallagher pickup, the Possee made a clutch grab in Chad Clark, and Pints regained their other Butterworth. "D" Division: Oh, hmmm... some more teams that are pretty dang different. Tha always makes things tough. But I'm ignoring the noise, and saying that the Bottoms Up climb continues. I'll take Menace and their Gustavo Martinez pickup to reel in second, followed by the very different She Said (and I'm calling Matt Dillon as an early division leader candidate). We'll go with Off Constantly and Duck Fook just barely outdueling the Wonders next. Which leaves the recently very altered Lonerider (who will climb a bit here if Rick DeMattos is actually playing), and the quite new (and thus difficult to predict) Main Street Mayhem, who might surprise a few. "E" Division: I was all ready to type something very different here... Then th Dartifacts re-added Juan Mata-Adams to their roster (he wasn't there to start with), and poof, it's done. I'm on the Dartifacts train. Going to be a serious fight behind them, with the Dart Knights and their big O'Toole pickup slotting in just ahead of the Cheapies. Off Constantly (swapping Lueneburg for Azevedo) and the Rangers will then outrun the half-different Corks and Rippin. Which leaves the new (and incredibly difficult to parse out) Aim For Fame. Two A stalwarts plus G regulars... they're going to win some, but how many? Fischlein is going to crush here in E. "F" Division: Oh, dude, talk about a race with no obvious favorites. Wow, so many teams could win this. I think I will take the Machine, maybe just ahead of the Dart Bags. I would love to take Bangin, but they burned me last season, so they'll have to settle for a mid-pack prediction, along with Nein Mark, Dartness, and the Sofa Kings. I think I'm stunned to see a Mathews-less Death Throw, so I dropped them down a bit, where they'll be battling with We're Sexy & We Throw It. "G" Division: This set of G rosters is mostly static, but there are a three-pack of longtime RDL stalwarts making new appearances here - Tony Keller has dropped after years with the top Sharky's team, Jim Hunsberger is back after just a few years away, and Jeff Dahulich is making his first RDL appearance in 11 years! In the end, I really have to go with Keller's new home, the Shark Shooters. I'm thinking Salute might climb all the way to 2nd, outpacing She-nanigans, Flight Club, Diddler on the Roof, and Bright Side. I have the almost-entirely new Double Vision next, but they

might surprise here. And Bayou will start by just not forfeiting out this time :o).

# THE PAGE OF INFORMATION THAT I RUN EVERY SEASON...

This is the place where I remind all of you of several things so that you can't say "I didn't know that" later on when you screw up. Sort of takes the blame off me if any of these bad things happen... which I sort of consider to be a good thing...

Some of these things change over the years, some don't... but please read them again. This stuff is really important for the smooth flow of our nights out with our hobby.

## COPIES OF COMPLETED SCORESHEETS

Keep a copy - it's as simple as that. I could give you all the reasons why, but I've done that a hundred times. Just **keep a copy of your sheet**, even if you lose, because you just never know when one o them will be lost by the postal service or your opponents. Hey, it has happened in twenty-five of the last forty-one season...

## **EMAILED TONS OF NEWSLETTER - UPDATED FA24**

We have been emailing the Tons of Newsletter for many years now. And we will, of course, be continuing that this season, in a sense - each week, I send a link to the RDL website with a notification that I've posted the new newsletter there. All you need is a relatively recent version of either Microsoft Excel or a PDF Reader like Adobe Acrobat, based on which file version you want to download. Oh, also, you need to not be a whiner, or an ass, or just difficult to like - if that's you, you'll just have to keep the checking the website you self, as I will certainly remove you from the weekly reminder list.

Beyond just generally not sucking, you don't need to do anything to stay on the email list if you were already on it, as the list carries over from season to season. If you would like to be removed from the list, simply email me back and let me know. If you weren't on the list and you would like to receive it, just email my address listed on page 4 and I'll add you to the list.

I generally send the notice of a new Tons in the range of Sunday to Tuesday. Sometimes it's earlier, and every so often a super busy week might instead push it back to Wednesday morning... but generally it will come in the Sunday to Tuesday window. [And on a related note, you can also download past issues (and even historical compilations!) anytime from the league website.]

## SIMPLE TRUTHS THAT YOU SHOULD NEVER FORGET

- 1. Any player who plays in a match without properly registering and paying dues (register with the League Membership Director, pay the League Treasurer) prior to throwing is an ineligible player. Playing an ineligible player will cost your team its win (if you did indeed win), all game points from that match, and all statistics from that match, regardless of how well or poorly that ineligible player did.
- 2. Any player who doesn't play in any of the four primary sets of the match, but plays in the 1001 tiebreaker is an ineligible player see number 1 (above) for the horror of this mistake.
- 3. Indicate which players of <u>both</u> teams took part in 1001 games on the front of the scoresheet. This is <u>MANDATORY</u>, and allows us to check for ineligible players, record statistics, etc.
- 4. If you ever know that your team is going to miss a match, do us a favor and call the opposing captain AND the host establishment (please!). Thank you very much.
- 5. Wednesday player additions are not allowed. It turns out that Board members have dart matches too, so all roster additions are required to be completed no later than 9pm Tuesday for any player to play in that week's match.

## MANY SCORESHEET RETURN PATHS AVAILABLE -BUT NOT ENTIRELY THE SAME AS IN RECENT YEARS

We have three routes remaining for turning in your scoresheets.. First, you can use your scanner (or your phone in some cases and email me an image of the sheet (my email addresses are in the Tons every week and also on the back of the scoresheet)

Second, you can shoot me photos of your scoresheet if you want to take care of returning it immediately! Just make sure you have good lighting, you're close enough to the sheet, and it's IN FOCUS. (note: out-of-focus or overly dark photos will not be acceptable... duh). And you can send those photos by email or text (as with my email addresses, my phone number is on the scoresheet back).

Finally, you can still use the old school U.S. Postal Service. My address is also on the back of the scoresheet, but I caution you... I still predict that this system will go away before too long (as I haven't received one via this route for many years now... plus the duration of a pandemic!).

[Quick note if you do actually decide to send me a hard copy via the snail mail side of things. Buying a (\$1.50-ish?) certificate of mailing could prove to be a nice piece of evidence if your scoresheet ever gets lost in the mail. Do NOT send your scoresheet by certified mail - I do NOT want to have to go to the post office repeatedly (or at all, to be honest) to sign for your scoresheets.]

If you use any of the modern electronic methods, I'll even email or text you a quick confirmation of receipt (since I'll have your email address or phone number, of course) - thus eliminating any worry about whether the sheet got through to me :0).

## NO CALL-IN REQUIREMENT FOR MATCH RESULTS

As of the Fall 2017 season, winning teams are no longer required to call in match results each week. And actually, the league long ago discontinued the VoiceMail number. Not enough use of it to warrant the cost any longer.

## TEAM NAMES ON YOUR SCORESHEETS

Every season there are several instances of teams listing the team names on opposite sides of the scoresheets (meaning one team's name is written above the other team's players). Obviously, I will eventually figure these out when the names under a team name aren't on the roster, but it would be cool if you simply indicate the error in some way (or simply flip the names - I would rather an away team be on the home side and vice versa than have the wrong people ANI THUS BACKWARDS FINAL SCORE under each side). ## CHECK BOTH SCORESHEETS

We run an item like this every season, and sometimes more than once. And here it is again because it's often needed repeatedly. When you are signing scoresheets at the end of the night, it is up to you to make sure that they match. If the other team turns in a sheet without your ASP or fast game or something, it really sort of doesn't exist... In RDL, not on the sheet = didn't happen.
